Spudded 12 1/4-inch hole at 1:00 PM, September 6, 1956. Drilled to 280 feet in red beds. Ran 9 joints (267.37 feet) 8 5/8-inch OD, 24 pound, J-55, 8 Rd thread, ST&C, new casing. Cemented casing at 278 feet with 150 sacks 1:1 cement and Halliburton Pozmix. Cement circulated. Plug down 5:30 PM, September 6, 1956. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 700 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and drilled 7 7/8-inch hole ahead.
