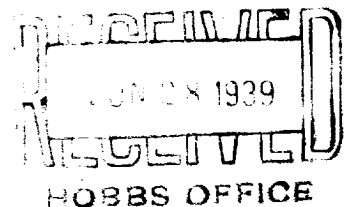

The 8 5/8" casing was set at 315' and cemented with 125 sack. The cement was circulated to the surface. Cement will be allowed to set 48 hours before drilling plugs. Plug was pumped down at 12; A.M. June 27 and will be drilled out on the morning of June 28.
