DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After setting 5 1/2" casing at 3695' and cementing with 300 sacks on March 28, 1940 cement was allowed to set for 72 hours. On March 31st the pipe was tested by applying 1000 pounds pressure to casing and let set for 30 minutes, no drop in pressure was noted and drilling was resumed.
