Re: Application to Dually Complete
Gulf Oil Corporation's J. F. Janda
"F" No. 7, Jalmat Gas and South
Eunice Oil Pools, Lea County, New
Mexico.

Gentlemen:

In this letter of application, Gulf Oil Corporation wishes to state the following:

(a) That by DC-392 dated January 12, 1957, Gulf Oil Corporation received authority to dually complete J. F. Janda "F" No. 9 in the South Eunice Oil and Jalmat Gas Pools. We now request DC-392 be cancelled.

(b) That Gulf Oil Corporation's J. F. Janda "F" No. 7 located in the G. W. O. Section 4-228-36E, was completed on 11-13-56 at a PB total depth of 3881'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on the Gulf Oil Corporation's J. F. Janda "F" lease together with the location of all offset wells. The attached Exhibit "B" shows a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion.

(c) That subject well has 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set at 3885' and cemented with 1200 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well producing from the perforated interval from 3815-3850' from the Queen formation in the South Eunice Pool.

(d) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:

(1) Perforate the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing within the approximate intervals of 3185-3220' in the Yates formation in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

(2) Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 3780' to separate the two pay zones.

(3) Produce the South Eunice Pool oil through the tubing and the Jalmat gas through the tubing casing annulus.



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That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the interval and oil from the Smith Sand is in the interest of conservation and the protection of cumulative rights.

That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two reservoirs.

That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is technically feasible and practical.

That by copy of this letter of application, all affected operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the subject well as described in this application.

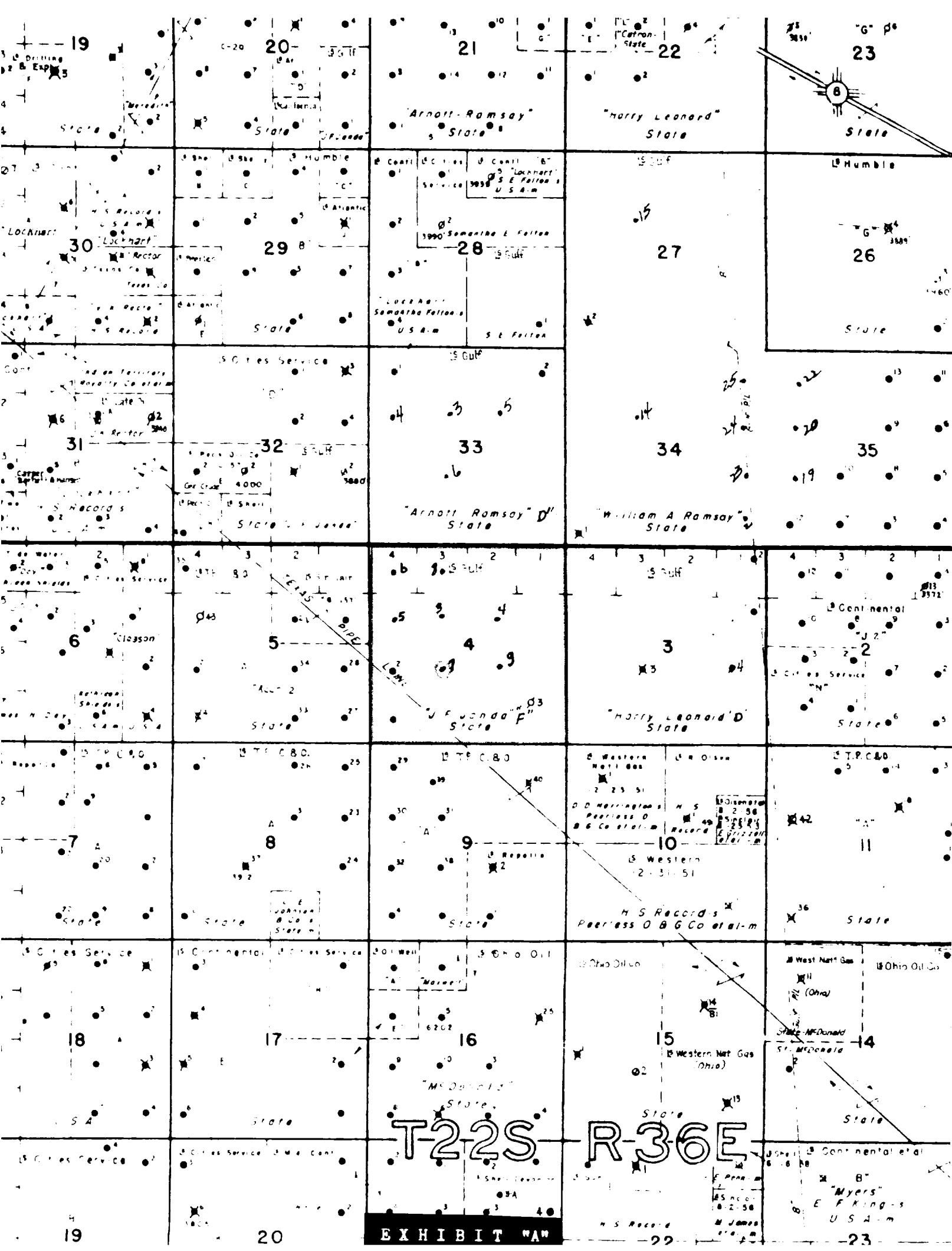


EXHIBIT "B"
