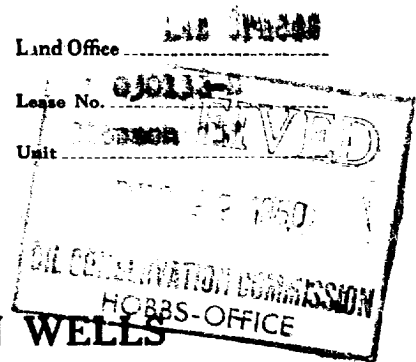

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 227 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

This well was drilled and completed November 16, 1940 in Green River producing horizon at 3816', plugged back to 3350' with cement and the hole loaded with sand. This well was plugged back in June 1950.  
 The 9 1/2" casing was shot off at 1246' and reclaimed approximately 1231' of same. The 8-5/8" casing was shot off at 126' and reclaimed approximately 211' of same. Ran 50 sacks of cement at 1648' and got 140' of fill up. Ran 50 sacks cement at 213' and got 128' of fill up. Ran 25 sacks of cement at 60' and filled up into cellar. A 4" - 4" pipe, plugged on the top, was left for a marker at the abandoned location. All surface equipment was reclaimed, cellar filled, location leveled and raked. Approval to plug this well was given June 21, 1950.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
