DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Subject well was deepened to 3955' and five inch liner set at 3949'. Cemented with 200 sacks, perforated 3874-80', 6 shots per foot. Washed with 500 and 1000 gallons acid, bridge set at 3905. Plugged back to 3879' with hydromite. Perforated 3840-50. Acidized with 1000 and 3000 gallons. Plugged back 3844 reacidized with 2000 gallons on February 1, 1954, and tested 30 bbls oil plus 30% water in 24 hours.
