DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

To Drill & Complete Water Well #1, located 1650' North of South line & 660' West of East line of Section 26, On June 29, 1942, Form C-101 was filed giving above location for N. M. State "G" #3 oil well. The hole was spudded at 10:00 AM 6-28-42 and drilled to a depth of 216' where 212' of 10-3/4" casing was set and cemented with 70 sacks Lone Star cement on July 6, 1942. On July 13th an Amended Form C-101 was filed giving a new location for N. M. State "G" #3 oil well. It was decided to make this hole into a water well by perforating the 10-3/4" casing with 30 shots from 155' to 165' and erecting a windmill and installing pumping equipment. To be known as N. M. State "G" Water Well #1.
