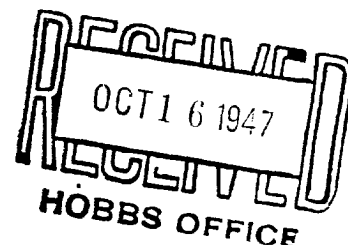

Acidized perforations from 6567' to 6547' w/ 500 gallons 15% acid. Recovered 1.5 barrels per hour. Reacidized w/ 750 gallons 15% acid and well made 40.58 barrels in 24 hours. G.O.R. 1169 to 1. Testing continues.
