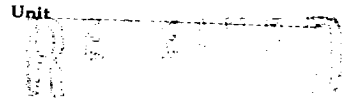

TD 4320' with five 5-1/4" & 5-3/8" o.d. drill collars stuck in interval 4137' - 4260'. propose to run 4-1/2" o.d. 11.6 lb J-55 csg. liner to 4135' and hang from 11/2 liner hanger at approximately 3700'. Cement with 100 sacks and test liner and casing. Will not attempt to see on well; but will recompleate in course - nearly pay.
