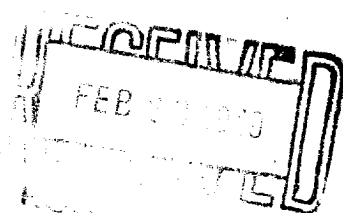

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 9:00 o'clock p.m., February 14, 1949, forty-eight (48) hours had elapsed since setting 5" casing (3774') and 5½" casing (2966') at 6750' which was cemented w/65 sacks. At this time pipe and water shut off was tested by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes, before and after drilling the cement plug. Pressure did not drop in excess of 100 psi, which satisfactorily meets the requirements. Drilling operations were resumed.
