Plugged back from 5321' to 5190' to test perforations from 5100' to 5080'. Pumped well 24 hrs. made 46 bbls. fluid 98% salt water. Squeezed off perforations from 5080' to 5173' with 500 sacks cement. Drilled out cement and bailed out Ottawa sand to 5318'. Pumped well 24 hrs. made 118 bbls. fluid 18 bbls. oil and 100 bbls. water.
