Dear Mr. Porter,

The Western Oil Fields, Inc., respectfully requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission consider this application for administrative approval to dually complete the Gulf State No. 1 Well, located NE/4, NE/4, Section 36, Township 22S, Range 37E.

We propose to complete in the Blinbry Oil Zone, the well now produces from the Tubb Gas Zone. These two zones have previously been authorized by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for dual completion in other wells within a one-mile radius from the subject well.

The petitioner, Western Oil Fields, Inc., will:

1. Perforate the Blinbry Zone from 5560-5670.
2. The Tubb Gas Zone now produces from perforations 5910-6040.
3. Utilize permanent production packer and snap set dual retrievable packer to maintain and assure segregation of the two zones.
4. Produce the Blinbry Oil Zone through 2 3/8" O.D. tubing and the Tubb Gas Zone from the casing.

The manner and method of dually completing is mechanically feasible and will prevent commingling from the two reservoirs.

Dear Mr. Foster:

The Western Oil Fields, Inc., respectfully requests
that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission consider this
application for administrative approval to install complete the
Oil State No. 1 Well, located NE1/4, Section 36, Town-
ship 22S, Range 7E.

We propose to complete in the Elmer's Oil Zone,
the well now producing from the Tubo Gas Zone. These two zones
have previously been submitted by the New Mexico Oil Conserva-
tion Commission for their completion in other wells within a
one-mile radius from the well.

The completion, Western Oil Fields, Inc., will:

1. Perforate the Elmer's Zone from 5500-5550.
2. The Tubo Gas Zone now produces from perforations 5010-5040.
3. Utilize permanent production packer and sand set dual completion packer to maintain and assure segregation of the two zones.
4. Produce the Elmer's Oil Zone through 2 1/2" N.P. well-
bore and the Tubo Gas Zone from the casing.

The above and method of dual completion is well-
established and will prevent crossflowing from the two
zones.
