Pool and Tubb Gas Pool, Lea County,
New Mexico

Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. hereby makes application for approval of 80-acre Elinebry and Tubb non-standard gas proration units comprising the $\frac{3}{2}$ of the $\frac{SW}{4}$ of Section 29, T-22-S, R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following:

1. TEXACO Inc. is the owner and operator of the A. H. Elinebry (NCT-2) Well No. 5 located in Unit "B", 660 feet from the south and west lines of Section 29, T-22-S, R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Location of this well is shown on the attached plat. TEXACO Inc. proposes to recomplete this well as a gas-gas dual in the Elinebry and Tubb Gas Pools.
2. TEXACO Inc. is owner and operator of an 80-acre oil and gas lease known as the A. H. Elinebry (NCT-2) Lease, comprising 80 acres covering the $\frac{3}{2}$ of the $\frac{SW}{4}$ of Section 29, T-22-S, R-38-E, upon which Well No. 5 is located and proposes that this acreage be established as 80 acre non-standard gas proration units in exception to Rule 5(A) of Order R-610 and Rule 5(a) of Order R-586, Elinebry and Tubb Gas Pools, respectively, with Well No. 5 as the unit well.
3. The proposed non-standard gas proration units meet the requirements of Rule 5(B) of Order R-610, Elinebry Gas Pool, and Rule 5(d) of Order R-586, Tubb Gas Pool, as follows:
 - (a) The units are comprised of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
 - (b) The proposed units lie wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed units may reasonably be presumed to be productive of Elinebry and Tubb gas.

and Tubb non-standard gas production units consisting of S/2 of the SW/4 of
Section 29, T-22-S, R-30-E, Las Alamos, New Mexico, and in support thereof
states the following:

1. THACO Inc. is the owner and operator of the A. H. Hildreth
(T-22-S) Well No. 1 located in the SW/4 of Section 29, T-22-S, R-30-E, Las Alamos, New Mexico. Location of this well
is shown on the attached plat. THACO Inc. proposes to redevelop this well
as a gas-gas dual in the Hildreth and Tubb gas pools.

2. THACO Inc. is owner and operator of an 80-acre oil and gas
lease known as the A. H. Hildreth (T-22-S) lease, comprising 80 acres covering
the S/2 of the SW/4 of Section 29, T-22-S, R-30-E, upon which Well No. 1 is
located and proposes that this acreage be established as 80 acre non-standard
gas production units in exception to Rule 5(A) of Order H-610 and Rule 5(a) of
Order H-610, Hildreth and Tubb gas pools, respectively, with Well No. 1 as the
lead well.

3. The proposed non-standard gas production units meet the requirements
of Order H-610 of Order H-610, Hildreth and Tubb gas pools, and Rule 5(a) of Order H-610,
Tubb gas pool, as follows:

- (a) The units are comprised of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- (b) The proposed units are wholly within a single governmental section.
- (c) All acreage within the proposed units was previously to be produced
to be productive of Hildreth and Tubb gas.

- (d) The lengths or widths of the proposed units do not exceed 2540 feet.
- (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interest in the quarter section in which the proposed units are located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of TEXACO Inc. to form the proposed non-standard gas proration units. (Addressee list on attached plat.)

Based upon the facts recited above, TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission approve administratively the non-standard gas proration units described above.

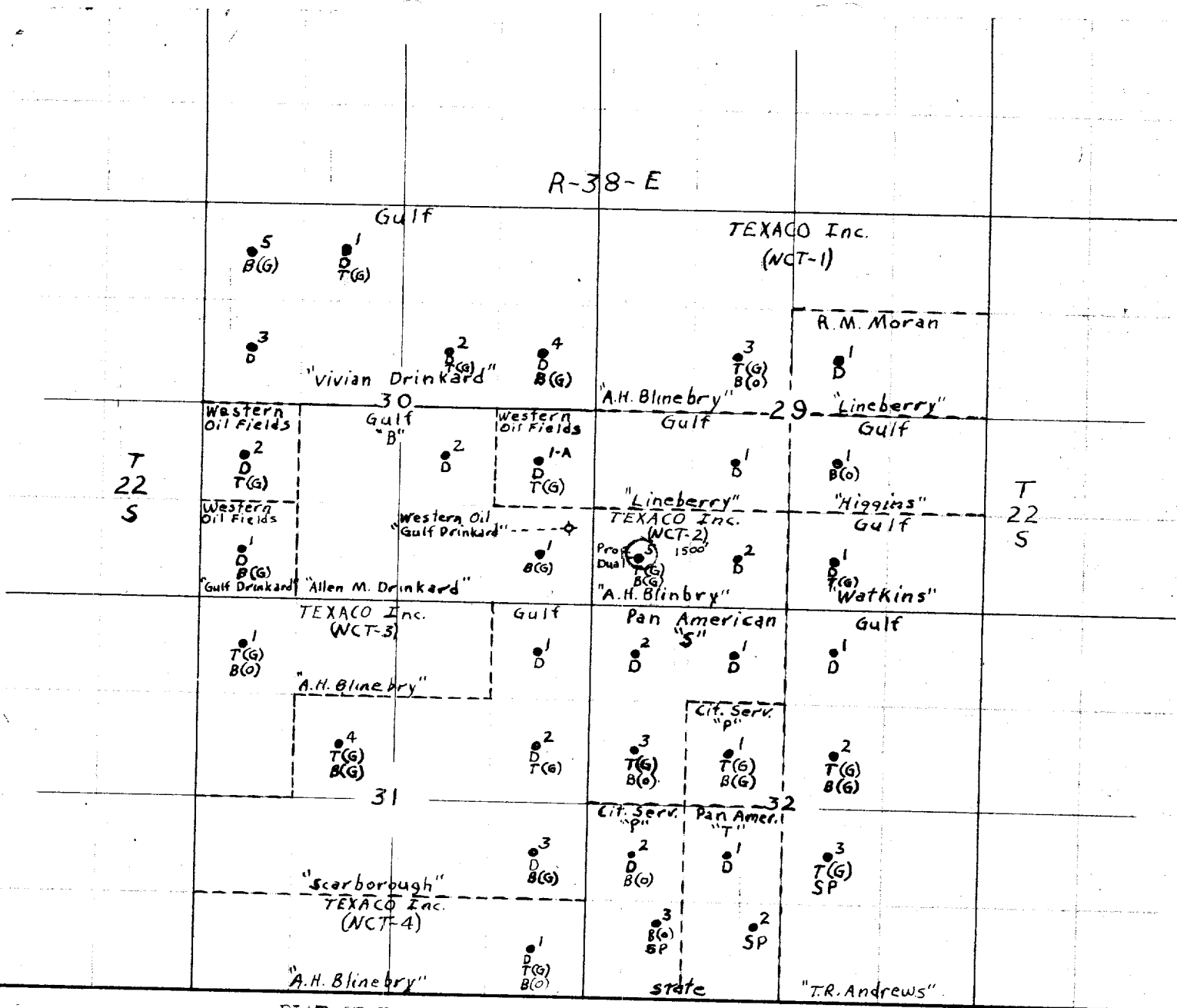
