Hole was treated with 4000 gallons acid below 5 1/2" casing cemented at 6900'. Initial treating pressure 2000#; final treating pressure 1700#.

Ran swab eight times and well kicked off flowing to pits. Well flowed average of 5 barrels oil per hour for first 24 hours.

No potential test taken on well before acid treatment.
