4-26-67 Granite Wash was perforated with 1 - 0.48" JPF @ 7264', 7266', 7268', 7271', 7275', 7277' & 7279' in conjunction with work performed on Blinebry reservoir. These new perforation were not tested and the well plugged back temporarily with a RBP @ 5660' in order to work on the Blinebry.

It is proposed at this time to temporarily abandon the Granite Wash reservoir for a period of approximately 90 days for extended testing of the Blinebry. At such time as we retrieve the bridge plug and again dual complete the captioned well, a new potential on the Granite Wash will be filed.
