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## 10. Plans for Restoration of the Surface:

- A. After completion of drilling and/or completion operations, all equipment and other material not needed for operations will be removed. Pits will be filled and location cleaned of all trash and junk to leave the wellsite in an aesthetically pleasing a condition as possible.
- B. Any unguarded pits containing fluids will be fenced until they are filled.
- C. After abandonment of the well, surface restoration will be in accordance with the agreement with the surface owner and accomplished as expeditiously as possible. Letter of agreement attached.

## 11. Other Information:

- A. Topography: Land surface is rolling and duny.
- B. Soil: Soil is a fine sand underlain with caliche.
- C. Flora & Fauna: The vegetative cover is generally sparse and consists of shinnery oak, mesquite, sparse perenial native range grasses and grass burs. The wild life in area consists of game birds, coyotes, reptiles and rodents.
- D. Ponds & Streams: None
- E. Residences and other structures: None
- F. Land Use: Grazing and hunting in season with surface owners permission.
- G. Surface Ownership: Wellsite is on fee land belonging to Mr. Millard Deck,
  Box 1047, Eunice, N.M. Copy of Land Owner Agreement & road restoration requirements by Mr. Deck is attached.
