Order No. R-3722, the captioned well has been dually completed to produce oil from the Yates Formation in the interval 3019 feet to 3135 feet through 2-3/8 inch tubing and to dispose of produced salt water into the Seven Rivers Formation in the interval from 3172 feet to 3197 feet through a parallel string of 3/4 inch plastic lined tubing with separation of the zones by a HOWCO R-3 packer set at 3150 feet. 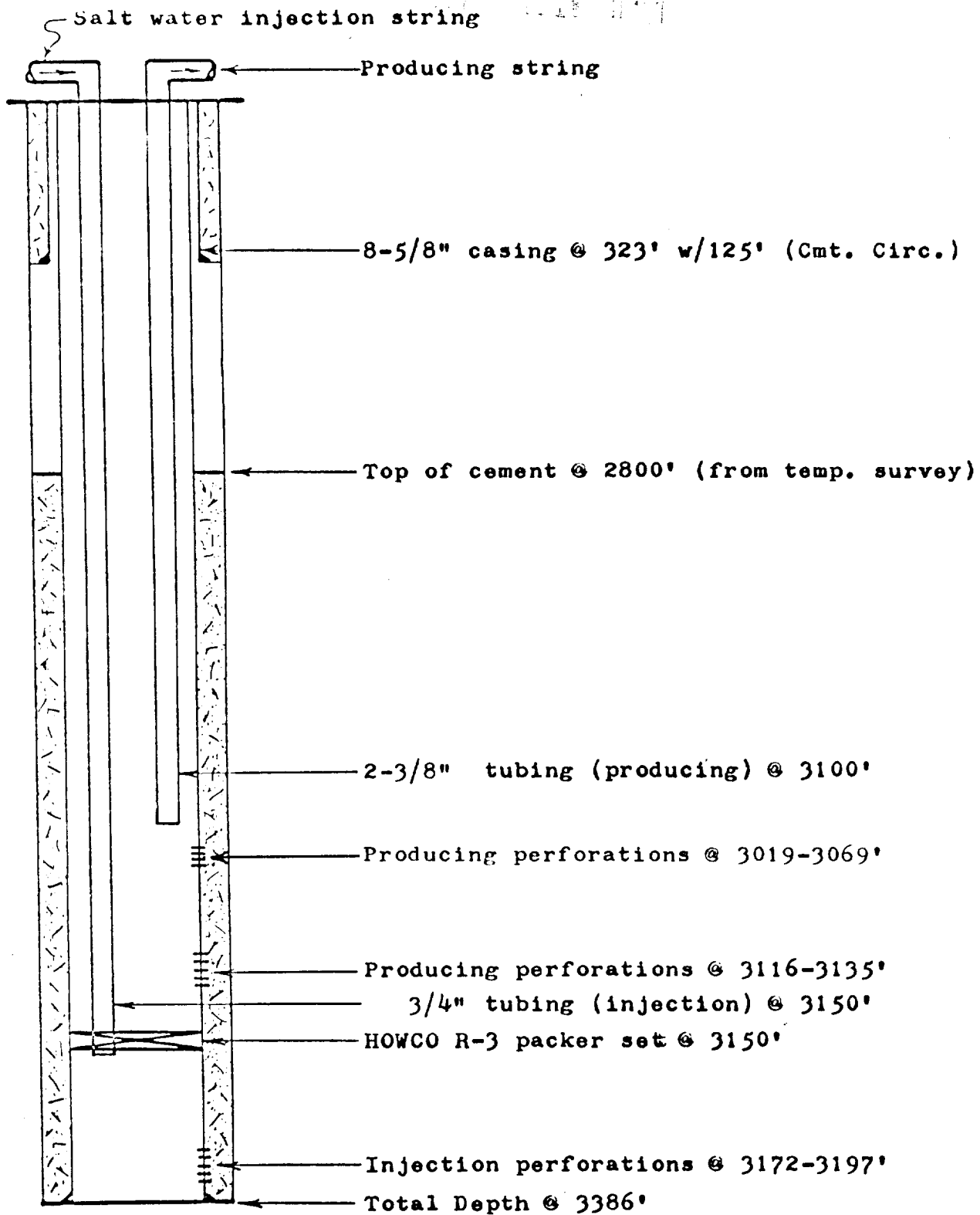
