Perforated at 5347-49', 5408-10', 5450-52' w/G-70 decentral gum 4 hyperjets per ft. Ran 2-3/8" tbg, set at 5258'. Pumped 3000 gals 7-1/2" RCM ball every 120 gals. Avg. press. 3600#, AIR 5 BPM, ISIP 1300#.

Fraced down 5-1/2" OD csg w/21,000 gals gelled mod brine and 27,000 lbs. 20-40 sand in 3 stages of 1,000 gals pad and 6,000 gals w/1-1/2 ppg sd, each stage separated w/8 - 1" RCM balls and 500 gals 15% NEA. Avg. press 2700#, AIR 34 BPM, ISIP 1500#. Retrieved 114 BO, 0 BW, 530 MCF, OOR 4649 on 18/64" choke. FTP 560, ISIP 1320.

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations, when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; and of other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
