Reference is made to your application on behalf of Lewis B. Burleson, Inc. for a 160-acre non-standard proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Jalmat Gas Pool:

Lea County, New Mexico, Township 25 South,  
Range 36 East, NMPM, Section 24: W/2 E/2.

It is my understanding that this unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to your Ascarte "C-24" Well No. 1 located 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit B) and to the Ascarte "D-24" Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the South line and East line (Unit J), both in said Section 24. Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the unit from these wells in any proportion.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, governing the Jalmat Gas Pool, the above non-standard gas spacing and proration unit is hereby approved.

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REMARKS: Division Order No. R-498, dated July 7, 1954, authorized an 80-acre non-standard proration unit in the Jalco Gas Pool (later changed to Jalmat Gas Pool) consisting of the W/2 NE/4 of said Section 24 and dedicated to the above-described Ascarte "C-24" Well No. 1. Division Order No. R-499, dated July 7, 1954, also authorized an 80-acre unit in the old Jalco Gas Pool consisting of the W/2 SE/4 of said Section 24 and dedicated to the above-described Ascarte "D-24" Well No. 1. Both of these orders are hereby stayed until further notice.
