Gas Supplement No. (SE) SF 605 dated May 26, 1959, was received in this office June 18, 1959 and showed subject well reclassified non-marginal from March 1, 1959.


The overproduction assessed against this well was calculated on the 1958 Deliverability of 55 MCF. The increased production since March 1959 is the result of cleaning out and installing tubing in the well February 7-14, 1959. Workdone and results were reported on C-103 March 20, 1959; Multi-point Back Pressure Test was run April 6-10, 1959 and reported on C-122 April 30, 1959; Deliverability Test was run April 10-17, 1959 and reported on C-122-C May 5, 1959 for a deliverability of 272 MCF after workover.

We feel we have fulfilled the requirements of Rule 6 (f)(2) of Order R-1092-A so that the new deliverability of 272 MCF should be effective about March 22, 1959. Would you please check your records to see if the recalculation of allowable should not be based on 272 MCF deliverability from March 22, 1959.

Form C-104 covering this workover is attached in case you feel it is required. We did not file the C-104 previously as we interpreted the requirements to increase the allowable of this well as being fulfilled by the proper filing of the C-103, C-116, C-110, C-122 and C-122-C.
