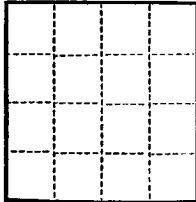

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3246 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is our intention to drill a well with rotary tools at the above location to a depth of approximately 3,700 feet, unless commercial production is encountered at a lesser depth. All casing will be cemented in accordance with methods approved by the United States Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with. The following casing pattern will be used:

9-5/8" casing will be set at approximately 300 feet, cemented with 300 sacks.
7" casing will be set at approximately 3,400 feet, cemented with 150% of the volume of cement required to bring the cement to above the base of the salt.


If the cement behind the 7" casing should circulate, no temperature survey will be run. If the cement does not circulate, a temperature survey will be run and if necessary the 7" casing will be perforated and recombed to bring the top of the cement above the base of the salt.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
