Subject: Complaint concerning improper disposal of oilfield waste near a City Fresh Water Wellhead Protection (WHP) area.

Re: AOC well and tank battery located at UL I-sec 7-Ts16s-R34e.

Dear Mr. Afghahi:

New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) has received a complaint from the New Mexico Environmental Department and the City of Carlsbad, NM concerning improper disposal of oilfield waste into an unlined pit and no berms around the tank battery at the above referenced location. The complainant's concern is the fact that AOC's operations at the above referenced location is in close proximity to a public water supply well owned by the City of Carlsbad, NM. Please note the US EPA and the State of NM monitors such wells and well head protection areas.

The NMOCD has performed an inspection of the above referenced facility and has noted the following deficiencies of your operations.

1. AOC is utilizing an unlined pit for disposal. The pit was noted to contain oily contaminated soils and RCRA non-exempt waste, such as buckets, cans, spray cans, used oil filters, thread protectors, etc. (See attached photo).
2. AOC has no signs which is required pursuant to NMOCD rules.
3. The tank battery does not have berms around it.

As a result of these findings AOC is hereby ordered to perform the following action items:

- A. Due to the RCRA non-exempt waste noted in the pit, AOC shall make a hazardous waste determination on the contents of the pit. This determination shall be pursuant to EPA RCRA 40 CFR part 261. Please note this determination must be made prior to any off-site disposal of this waste, and/or any closure activities. AOC shall provide to the NMOCD the results of its findings. If the contents of the pit is hazardous then AOC shall notify the NMED Hazardous Waste & Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB).
- B. Please submit to the NMOCD for approval a work plan which will describe in detail how AOC plans on closing the pit. The work plan shall include site assessment data, clean-up technology to be used, sampling and testing methods, and a schedule of activities. This plan can be pursuant to NMOCD Guidelines. After NMOCD receives AOC's plan then NMOCD will approve as is or with conditions.
- C. AOC shall install the required signs pursuant to NMOCD rule 103.
- D. Pursuant to NMOCD rule 310 and the fact that AOC is in close proximity to the City of Carlsbad's fresh water well, AOC will be required to dyke/berm this facility.

Please note AOC will have 60 days from receipt of this letter to perform and submit the required action items listed above. NMOCD can grant extensions to this deadline for good cause shown. Failure to comply with this request may result in AOC being issued a "Notice of Violation."

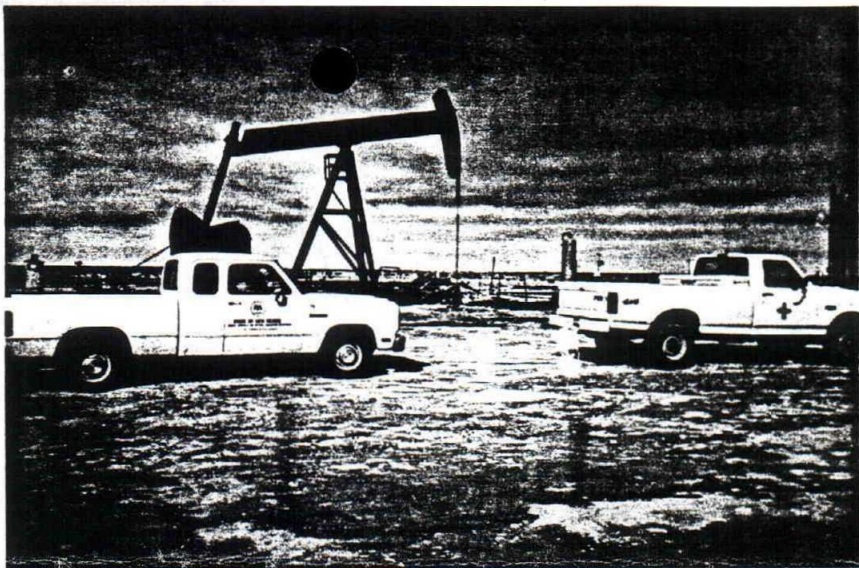

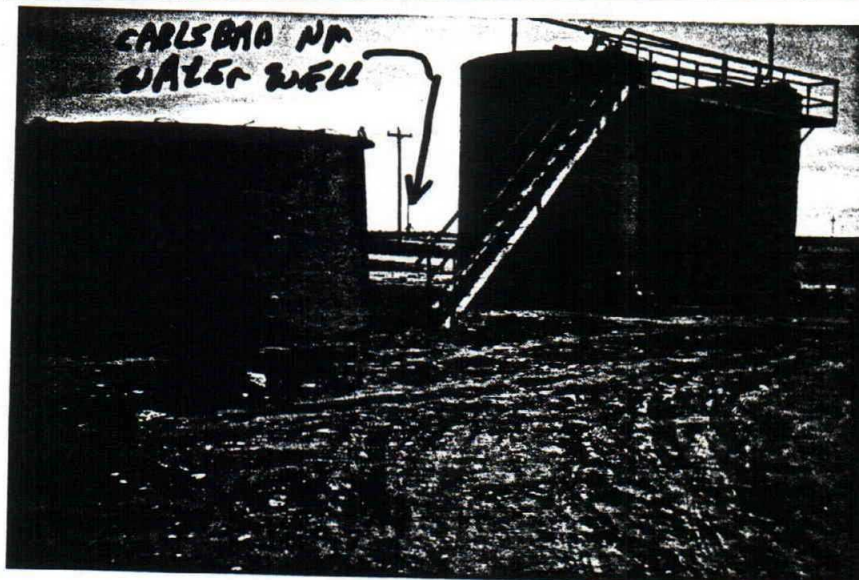

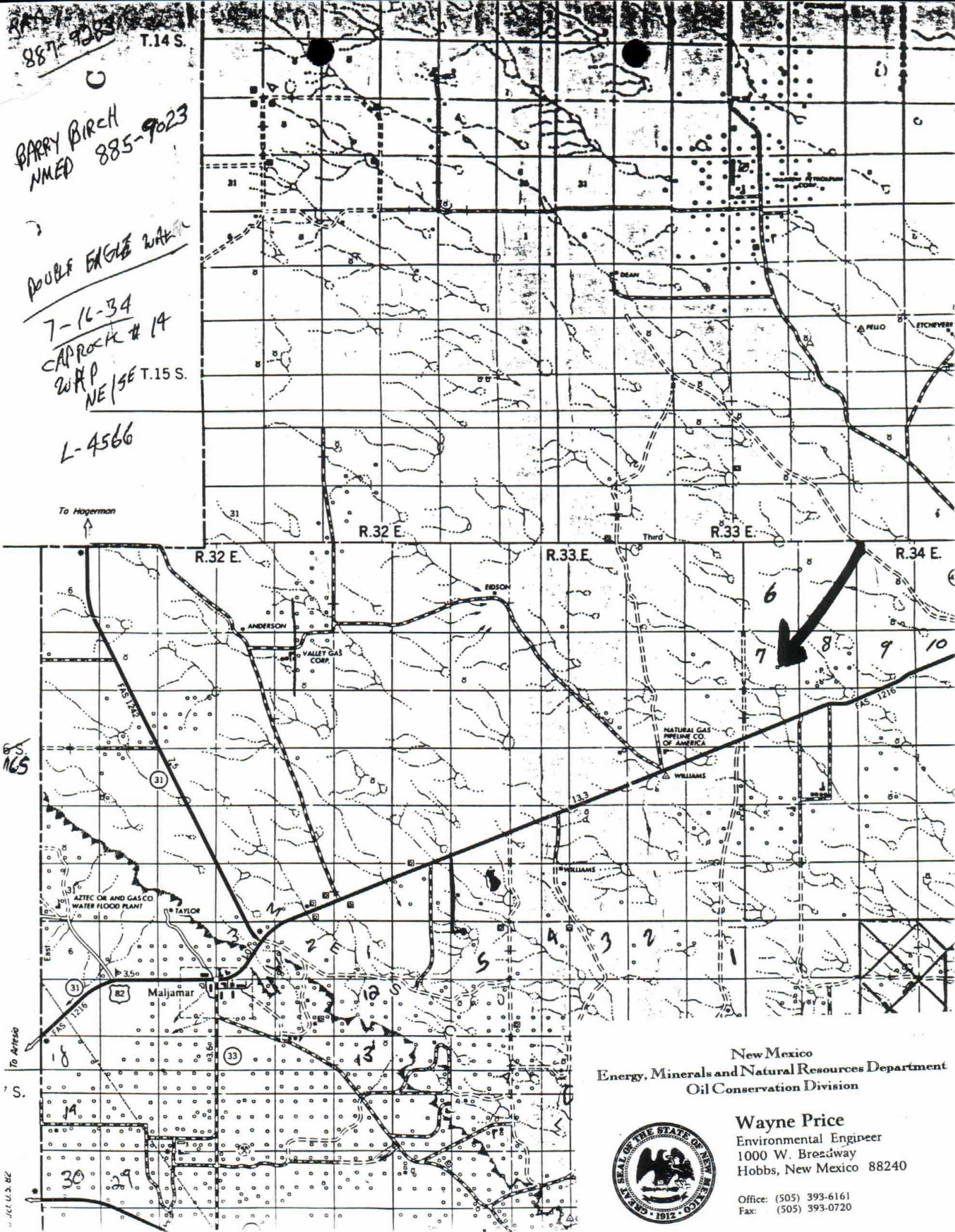
