Reference is made to your May 16, 2019 request on behalf of the operator ("operator") to extend the deadline stipulated in the above titled order to commence injection for the above referenced well for reasons outlined in your correspondence. The current deadline date to commence injection under said order is two years after issuance of the order: June 12, 2019.

It is the Division's understanding from your correspondence that since the date of issuance of this permit, there have been no changes in affected parties and no additional wells drilled in the one-half mile Area of Review.

The Division finds that for reasons you have stated, the granting of this request to extend this administrative order is in the interest of conservation, will prevent waste, and will protect the environment.

The deadline to commence injection for the existing order is hereby extended until June 12, 2020.

All requirements of the above referenced administrative order and agreements in the application remain in full force and effect.

Any additional extension of the deadline to commence injection for this administrative order will not be considered unless the operator has already commenced drilling out the plugs of the subject well. Otherwise, the injection authority Le Lower Les shall expire under the terms of the extended administrative order and the operator shall be required to submit a new application of out in injection authority for the referenced well.

apologize that I didn't respond to the email on May 22. The well is in an area for the Lesser Prairie Chicken which has work timing restrictions which are past our current time; The LPC Zone 1 Management Area includes occupied and historic lek locations, LPC observation areas not associated with a lek site, and adjacent habitats where -PC's are expected to occur. Within Zone 1, 3-D seismic and 24-hour human-controlled operations, such as drilling, are prohibited during the period of March 1st through June 15th. Activities such as construction are subject to timing restrictions – no activity between 3:00am and 9:00am between March 1st and June 15th. industrial noise, such as that caused by compressors and diesel engines, will be muffled or otherwise reduced to a level below 75 dB at 30 feet from the source of the noise. Ground level abandoned well markers will be installed instead of the standard 4 foot tall pipe, unless prohibited by law or the surface landowner.
