This one is also problematic. The footages for the FTP & LTP do not appear to be closer than 100/330 per the state-wide rule.

- SHL 325 FSL & 1325 FWL, SEC. 9, T24S-R35E (UNIT N)

- BHL 150 FNL & 2426 FWL, SEC. 4, T24S-R35E (UNIT 3)
- FTP 958 FSL & 2014 FWL, SEC. 9 (UNIT N) (2640 - 2014 = 626)
- LTP 150 FNL & 2126 FWL, SEC. 4 (UNIT 3) (2640 - 2126 =514)

I cannot see that you need a NSL for this well based on the above. Perhaps there is a typo somewhere or I am misunderstanding something.
