Cimarex Energy Co., OGRID Number 215099, is seeking administrative approval of an unorthodox well location ("NSL") for the **Tar Heel 19-8-7 Federal Com 2H well** (the "Well"), API No. 30-015-46561 to be completed within the Purple Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool (Pool ID: 98220) underlying Sections 18 and 19, and the SW4 of Section 7, Township 26 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. A C-102 for the Well is attached as Exhibit A. This is a horizontal well that will be drilled as follows:

- Surface Hole Location: 540' from the South line and 389' from the West line of Section 19;
- First Take Point: 540' from the South line and 330' from the West line of Section 19;
- Last Take Point/Bottom Hole Location: 2562' from the South line and 330' from the West line of Section 7.

Cimarex has included as Exhibit B a letter explaining why this application is needed. Cimarex also provides a map of the area, attached as Exhibit C, which shows the area upon which the unorthodox location will encroach.

This well will produce from the Purple Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool (Pool ID: 98220). The special pool rules establish 330' foot setback requirements. The

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last take point for the Well is closer than 330' from the boundary of the spacing unit. Specifically, the last take point would be 100' feet from the boundary of the unit because the SW/4 measures approximately 2662 feet (from South to North), as opposed to the traditional 2640 feet. *See* Exhibit A (C-102). The unorthodox location will encroach towards the NW/4 of Section 7 of Township 26 South, Range 30 East. Cimarex has confirmed that the tracts adjoining the spacing unit by a corner are more the 330' away from the unorthodox locations requested.

Pursuant to Rule 19.15.4.12(A)(2) and Rule 19.15.2.7(A)(3), Cimarex is providing notice to the operator of the NW/4 of Section 7 of Township 26 South, Range 30 East, which is XTO Holdings, LLC. Cimarex is also providing notice to the Bureau of Land Management. Proof of mailing, along with a copy of the notice letter sent to affected parties, is attached hereto as Exhibit D.

Dear Mr. Lowe:

Thank you for taking the time to speak with me about the four Cimarex Energy Co. NSL applications I submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the "Division") on November 4, 2021. As a reminder, the NSL applications are for four wells, one application per well. The wells are:

- **Tar Heel 19-8-7 Federal Com 2H well**
- **Tar Heel 19-8-7 Federal Com 3H well**
- **Tar Heel 19-8-7 Federal Com 18H well**
- **Tar Heel 19-8-7 Federal Com 19H well**

These four wells are within a standard horizontal spacing unit, which is an 800 acre, more or less, unit comprised of the W/2 of Sections 18 and 19, and the SW/4 of Section 7, Township 26 South, Range 30 East, as identified on each of the C-102s ("Dedicated Area" on C-102s identified as 801.73 acres). In the application cover letter, I described each well by quarter-quarter section location, to give a more precise location for each well, and I did not mean to suggest that the area has 40-acre building blocks and that each well is dedicated to a separate unit. Rather, all four wells are within a single unit, which is a combination of 320-acre building blocks and a 160-acre building block. Based on our conversation, it appears from your review of Division materials that combining 320-acre building blocks with 160-acre building blocks has been an accepted practice at the Division. I have attached a rough drawing showing the unit (outlined in red) and the approximate location of the wells within the unit, which is a marked up version of the map I previously provided showing XTO as the off-set in the NW/4 of Section 7.

I apologize for any confusion and hope this clears up any confusion I caused. Please let me know if I can provide any further information.
