EOG Resources Inc. (“EOG”) (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Lakewood 28 Fed Com #749 Well** (API No. 30-025-46852)¹ to be completed within the Bobcat Draw; Upper Wolfcamp Pool (Pool Code 98094) underlying the W½E½ of Sections 21 and 28, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, as follows:

- Surface Hole Location: 200' FSL and 2,143' FEL of Section 28
- Bottom Hole Location: 100' FNL and 2,590' FEL of Section 21
- First Take Point: 100' FSL and 2,590' FEL of Section 28
- Last Take Point: 100' FNL and 2,590' FEL of Section 21

Since this acreage is governed by the Division’s statewide rules, the completed interval for the **Lakewood 28 Fed Com #749 Well** is unorthodox because the completed interval is closer than the standard offsets to the eastern boundary of the spacing unit in the E½W½ of Sections 21 and 28. The **Lakewood 28 Fed Com #749 Well** encroaches on the adjoining spacing unit located in the E½W½ of Sections 21 and 28. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow EOG to optimize pressure related to the completion and production drawdown of the wells which

is expected to yield a higher ultimate recovery than a standard location, thereby preventing waste and protecting correlative rights.





A non-standard location is necessary to develop the Wolfcamp formation in these sections efficiently and in an economic manner.
