Wyoming Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than the standard offsets to the southern boundary of the spacing unit – thus encroaching on the N/2NE/4 of Section 3, T25S, R32E. Approval of the unorthodox, completed interval will allow Chevron to use its preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area, which will maximize recovery and prevent waste.

Exhibit A are Form C-102s showing the proposed CO Grizzly 34 27 Fed Com 407H well encroaches on the spacing unit/tracts to the south in the N/2NE/4 of Section 3, T25S, R32E.






