UNDERGROUND INJECTION CONTROL PROGRAM FORMAL NOTICE OF LOSS OF INJECTION AUTHORITY

Dear Operator,

This letter is to provide formal notice that the authority to inject into the well(s) identified in Attachment A has terminated pursuant to 19.15.26.12(C)(1) New Mexico Administrative Code ("NMAC"). This citation of the NMAC states as follows:

Abandonment of injection operations:

Whenever there is a continuous one-year period of non-injection into all wells in an injection or storage project or into a produced water disposal well or special purpose injection well, the division shall consider the project or well abandoned, and the authority for injection shall automatically terminate ipso facto.

Injection of any fluid into any of the identified wells is prohibited until a new injection permit is approved by the Director. Additionally, the operator of the identified wells must immediately ensure the well is shut-in and disconnected from incoming sources of disposal.

Failure to report disposal volumes to the Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") is considered as "non-injection" for purposes of triggering automatic termination of the authority to use the well for disposal. Pursuant to 19.15.7.24 NMAC, disposal volumes must be reported on or before the 15th day of the second month following the month of disposal on Form C-115 (Monthly Production Reports). In addition to the loss of injection authority, the failure to report is, in its own right, a violation that may be punishable under 19.15.5.10 (D) NMAC by assessing a civil penalty of no more than two thousand and five hundred dollars (\$2500) per day of noncompliance for each violation.

If you plan to continue the use of the well for disposal, you must apply for a new Underground Injection Control ("UIC") permit pursuant to 19.15.16.8 NMAC using Form C-108 and completing the requirements specified in the form. The approval of a UIC permit may be either through the administrative review process or through hearing. Submission of an administratively complete Form C-108 does not guarantee the OCD will approve a new UIC permit for the well.

The well(s) shall be shut in and must not be used for disposal purposes until the following have been approved and all conditions of approval completed. The well(s) must have the following prior to reopening:

- An Approved UIC permit
- A new passing Mechanical Integrity Test (MIT).
- The OCD has approved a new form C-105 for well(s).
- All conditions of approval in the UIC permit have been completed.

Please also be aware that pursuant to 19.15.25.8 NMAC or any applicable Agreed Compliance Order, there is a limited time in which a well(s) must be returned to service or abandoned through either proper temporary abandonment or plugging. For these deadlines, please refer to said rule or agreement.
