Dear Ms. Evans,

The Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”) has received your January 15, 2023, request to extend the authority to inject into the referenced well (“Well”) under the referenced administrative order SWD-1388 (“Order”).

When an operator fails to inject into a disposal well for a continuous one (1) year period, OCD shall consider the well to be abandoned, and the authority to inject into the well is terminated automatically under 19.15.26.12(C)(1) NMAC. However, the Director may, upon a request by the well operator and for good cause shown, grant an administrative extension prior to the end of the continuous one (1) year period or during the term of a previously granted extension under 19.15.26.12(C)(2) NMAC.

The OCD Director finds that your request is timely and good cause exists to grant your request to extend the authority to inject into the Well. The last record of injection is the Form C-115 filed for the month of April 2022 which required injection to commence by April 30, 2023, to avoid 19.15.26.12(C)(1) NMAC from taking effect.

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Accordingly, the authority to inject into the Well under the Order is extended until April 30, 2024, as provided under 19.15.26.12(C)(2) NMAC. Failure to restart injection into the Well by April 30, 2024, or failure to request an extension by this date will result in termination of the Order. This termination shall require the operator to submit a new application to establish a new authority to inject into the Well.

The remaining terms and conditions in the Order continue in full force and effect, including the requirement to maintain the mechanical integrity of the Well, and the requirements for temporary abandoned and inactive wells under 19.15.25 and 19.15.28 NMAC.
