- 5-What are the projected hours of operation?
- 6-What kinds of safety features will be in place?
- 7-How will surface spillage be addressed?

7a-In case of (inevitable) toxic spillage, what measures will be employed for:

7a1- clean up

7a2-prevention of runoff

8-Will this site be equipped with air quality monitoring devices (it it understood H2S isn't really an issue with dump sites, but it is in the area)

- 9-Will this site be fenced?
- 10- Has there been an environmental impact survey completed?
- 11- Has there been an archeological survey for Native American importance completed?
- 12- Although this site is on private property, it will require maintenance and inspections. Who is responsible for these duties, and what are their frequencies?
