Greetings, Mr. Puryear:

On July 15, 2025, COG Operating LLC ("COG") notified the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") that it is protesting the following SWD permit request application of Permian Oilfield Partners, LLC ("POP") for disposal:

- Southern Joule Federal SWD No. 1, Section 31, Township 25 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico

COG is identified as an affected person for the referenced application. For the application to proceed, POP has two options: either resolve the matter with the protesting party or go to a hearing before the Division. If the protest is withdrawn, then the application could be processed administratively. Meanwhile, OCD will retain your application until a resolution is reached on the status of the submittals.
