On April 22, 2026, the New Mexico State Land Office (“NMSLO”) notified the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”) that it is protesting the following WFX application of Rover Operating, LLC:

- Dove State No. 1, Unit J, Section 16, Township 16 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico

The NMSLO is identified as an affected person for the referenced application. For the application to proceed, Rover Operating, LLC has two options: either resolve the matter with the protesting party or go to hearing before the Division. If the protest is withdrawn, then the application could be processed administratively. Meanwhile, OCD will retain your application until a resolution is reached on the status of the submittals.
