
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Excess pressure caused the stuffing box packing on the wellhead to blow out 15 bbls of oil and 5 bbls of produced water onto location. A vacuum truck recovered 14 bbls of fluids and the stuffing box packing was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The affected area is approximately 175' x 150' with most of the leak staying on location. Remediation will be completed in accordance with a remediation plan approved by NMOCD and the BLM.

Subject: Lost Tank 3 Federal #21

This is to inform you that Oxy Permian had a spill at the Lost Tank 3 Federal #21 on May 3, 2016. Oxy spilled 15 bbls of oil and 5 bbls of produced water due to the stuffing box packing blowing out. The preliminary report shows the leak measuring approximately 60' x 100' both on and off location. A vacuum truck recovered 14 bbls of oil. The release is located in U/L E of Section 3, T22S, R31E of Eddy County, NM. Driving directions: Go east of Carlsbad on NM128 to MM10, turn left on Whipp Rd to dead end, turn left to MM2, pass the road closed signs and turn left, cross the CG and follow to dead end, turn right past the power station, take curve left past 4 pump jacks on left, turn on first right and location is at the dead end.
