**APPLICATION OF COG OPERATING LLC  
FOR COMPULSORY POOLING,  
EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.**

**APPLICATION**

COG Operating LLC (“Applicant”) (OGRID No. 229137), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation [Purple Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool (98220)] underlying a standard 1,538.88-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of all of Sections 21, 28, and 33, Township 26 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. In support of its application, COG states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the proposed horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.

2. Applicant seeks to dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the following proposed wells:

- The **Boo Radley Com 701H well**, and the **Boo Radley Com 702H well** to be drilled from a common surface hole location in SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 16 to bottom hole locations in the SE/4 NE/4 (Lot 4) of Section 33;
- The **Boo Radley Com 703H well** to be drilled from a surface hole location in SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 NE/4 (Lot 3) of Section 33;

- The **Boo Radley Com 704H well** and the **Boo Radley Com 705H well** to be drilled from a common surface hole location in SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 16 to bottom hole locations in the SE/4 NW/4 (Lot 2) of Section 33; and
- The **Boo Radley Com 706H well** to be drilled from a surface hole location in SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 NW/4 (Lot 1) of Section 33.

3. The completed interval for the proposed **Boo Radley Com 704H well** will be within 330' of the quarter-quarter line separating the W/2 and the E/2 of Sections 21, 28, and 33 to allow inclusion of the E/2 of Sections 21, 28, and 33 into a standard horizontal well spacing unit.

4. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all the interest owners in the subject spacing unit.

5. The pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

6. In order to permit Applicant to obtain it's just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all uncommitted interests in this horizontal spacing unit should be pooled and Applicant should be designated the operator of the proposed horizontal well spacing unit.


WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on September 10, 2020, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted interests in the horizontal spacing unit;

- B. Approving the initial wells in the horizontal spacing unit;
- C. Designating Applicant as the operator of this spacing unit and the horizontal wells to be drilled thereon;
- D. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping, and completing the wells;
- E. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- F. Imposing a 200% charge for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the wells against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the wells.
