VERIFIED STATEMENT OF ADRIANA SALGADO

Adriana Salgado, being duly sworn upon her oath, deposes and states:

- 1. I am a Landman for Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have worked as an associate landman for two years and a landman for three years. I hold a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Humanities from the University of Texas of the Permian Basin. I have 4 years of land work experience with Apache Corporation, prior to working at Mewbourne Oil Company. Collectively, I have 11 years of land work experience.
- 2. Pursuant to NMAC 19.15.4.12.A(1), the following information is submitted in support of the compulsory pooling application filed herein:
 - (a) The purpose of this application is to force pool working interest owners into the Bone Spring formation horizontal spacing unit described below, and in wells to be drilled in the unit.
 - (b) No opposition is expected because the interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed well but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests to the well. All interest owners have been located.
 - (c) A plat outlining the unit being pooled is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. Mewbourne seeks an order approving a 320.00-acre horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring Formation comprised of the W2SW of Section 17, the W2W2 of Section 20 and the W2NW of Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the North Wilson Deep Unit #3H. There are no depth severances in the Bone Spring Formation.
 - (d) The parties being pooled and their interests are set forth in Exhibit 2. Their current and correct addresses are also set forth.



- (e) Exhibit 3 contains a summary of contacts with the interest owners, together with copies of the proposal letters sent to them, delivery receipts for each and copies of all email correspondence as listed.
- (f) In order to locate the interest owners, Mewbourne examined the county records, performed internet searches, checked telephone records, and searched pertinent computer searches.
- (g) Mewbourne has made a good faith effort to obtain the voluntary joinder of the working interest owners in the proposed well.
- (h) Mewbourne has the right to pool the overriding royalty owners in the well unit.
- (i) Exhibit 4 is the Authorization for Expenditure for the proposed well. The estimated cost of the well set forth therein is fair and reasonable, and is comparable to the costs of other wells of similar depth and length drilled in this area Lea County.
- (j) Mewbourne requests overhead and administrative rates of \$8000/month for a drilling well and \$800/month for a producing well. These rates are fair, and comparable to the rates charged by other operators for wells of this type in this portion of Lea County. Mewbourne requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the standard COPAS. Accounting Procedure.
- (k) Mewbourne requests that the maximum cost plus 200% risk charge be assessed against non-consenting working interest owners.
- (l) Applicant requests that it be designated operator of the well.
- (m) The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me or under my supervision, or compiled from company business records.
- (n) The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.





Adriana Salgado, being duly sworn upon her oath, deposes and states:

- 1. I am a Landman for Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have worked as an associate landman for two years and a landman for three years. I hold a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Humanities from the University of Texas of the Permian Basin. I have 4 years of land work experience with Apache Corporation, prior to working at Mewbourne Oil Company. Collectively, I have 11 years of land work experience.
- 2. Pursuant to NMAC 19.15.4.12.A(1), the following information is submitted in support of the compulsory pooling application filed herein:
 - (a) The purpose of this application is to force pool working interest owners into the Bone Spring formation horizontal spacing unit described below, and in wells to be drilled in the unit.
 - (b) No opposition is expected because the interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed well but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests to the well. All interest owners have been located.
 - (c) A plat outlining the unit being pooled is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. Mewbourne seeks an order approving a 320.00-acre horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring Formation comprised of the E2SW of Section 17, the E2W2 of Section 20 and the E2NW of Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the North Wilson Deep Unit #3H. There are no depth severances in the Bone Spring Formation.
 - (d) The parties being pooled and their interests are set forth in Exhibit 2. Their current and correct addresses are also set forth.

- (e) Exhibit 3 contains a summary of contacts with the interest owners, together with copies of the proposal letters sent to them, delivery receipts for each and copies of all email correspondence as listed.





 - (a) Attachment A is a structure map on the base of the 2nd Bone Spring Sand. It shows that structure dips to the southwest. It also shows Bone Spring wells in the area, and a line of cross-section.
 - (b) Attachment B is a 2nd Bone Spring Sand Gross Thickness Map.
 - (c) Attachment C is a cross section of the 2nd Bone Spring Sand showing the target zones in the North Wilson Deep Unit Well Nos. 3H and 4H. The 3H well will target the lower 2nd Bone Spring Sand, and the 4H well will target the upper 2nd Second Bone Spring Sand.

The well logs on the cross-section give a representative sample of the 2^{nd} Bone Spring Sand in this area. The sand is continuous and uniformly thick across the well units.

- 4. I conclude from the maps that:
- (a) The horizontal spacing units are justified from a geologic standpoint.
- (b) The target zones are continuous and of relatively uniform thickness across the well units.



- (d) There is no faulting or other geologic impediment in the area which will affect drilling of the subject wells.
- 5. Attachment D contains production information from other Second Bone Spring Sand wells drilled in this area. The Second Bone Spring wells in this area are all standup wells.
- 6. Attachment E contains the horizontal drilling plans for the proposed wells. The producing intervals of the wells will be orthodox.
