AFFIDAVIT OF ROBERT HELBING (Landman)

Robert Helbing, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

- 1. My name is Robert Helbing and I am employed by MRC Energy Company, an affiliate of Matador Production Company ("Matador"), as a landman. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. I am familiar with the applications filed by Matador in these consolidated cases and the status of the lands in the subject area.
- 2. In these consolidated cases, Matador seeks orders pooling two standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing units in the Bone Spring formation (Malaga; Bone Spring pool [42780]) underlying Sections 14 and 15, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico as follows:
 - Under <u>Case 22052</u> Matador seeks to pool the N/2 N/2 of Sections 14 and 15 and initially dedicate this 320-acre spacing unit to the proposed **Bubba Burton Com #111H** and the **Bubba Burton Com #121H** wells to be drilled from surface locations in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 14 to bottom hole locations in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 15.
 - Under <u>Case 22053</u> Matador seeks to pool the S/2 N/2 of Sections 14 and 15 and initially dedicate this 320-acre spacing unit to the proposed the **Ken Wilson Com #112H** and the **Ken Wilson Com #122H** wells to be drilled from surface locations in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 14 to bottom hole locations in the SW/4 NW/4 (Unit E) of Section 15.

- 3. **Matador Exhibit C-1** contains draft Form C-102's in numerical order for the proposed initial wells in each of these standard spacing units. These forms demonstrate that the completed interval for each well will meet the standard setback requirements for horizontal oil wells.
- 4. **Matador Exhibit C-2** is a general location map outlining each of the proposed horizontal spacing units in red, with the lateral trajectory of the proposed wells with blue lines. This acreage is comprised of fee lands.
- 5. There are no depth severances within the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage.
- 6. **Matador Exhibit C-3** identifies the working interest owners that Matador seeks to pool in each of the proposed spacing units. The interest owners are percentage interests to be pooled are the same in both cases. Matador has conducted a diligent search of the public records in the county where the property is located, reviewed telephone directors and conducted computer searches to attempt to locate contact information for each of these working interest owners.
- 7. **Matador Exhibit C-4** contains a list of the overriding royalty owners that Matador seeks to pool in these cases. The list of overriding royalty owners is the same in each case.
- 8. **Matador Exhibit C-5** contains a sample of the well proposal letters and AFEs sent to the working interest owners Matador was able to locate. The costs reflected in these AFEs are consistent with what other operators have incurred for drilling similar horizontal wells in the area in these formations.
- 9. **Matador Exhibit C-6** contains a general summary of the contacts with the uncommitted working interest owners that Matador was able to locate. As indicated, Matador has

discussed verbally or exchanged emails with each pooled party, except for Drew McEwen. In addition to mailing the well proposal to address we were able to locate, I have attempted to call every phone number we were able to identify as possibly being for Mr. McEwen. In my opinion, Matador has undertaken good faith efforts to reach an agreement with the uncommitted mineral owners.

- 10. Matador requests that the overhead and administrative costs for drilling and producing the proposed wells be set at \$8,000 per month while drilling and \$800 per month while producing. These costs are consistent with what other operators are charging in this area for similar wells.
- 11. I have provided the law firm of Holland & Hart LLP with the names and addresses (where available) of the mineral owners that Matador seeks to pool and instructed that they be notified of this hearing.
- 12. **Matador Exhibits C-1 through C-6** were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.

Daniel Brugioni, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

1. My name is Daniel Brugioni and I am employed by MRC Energy Company, an

affiliate of Matador Production Company ("Matador"), as a petroleum geologist.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an

expert witness in petroleum geology. I am familiar with the applications filed by Matador in these

consolidated cases and have conducted a geologic study of the lands in the subject area.

3. The target intervals for the initial wells in the proposed spacing units are the First

and Second Bone Spring intervals of the Bone Spring formation.

4. **Matador Exhibit D-1** is a locator map outlining the horizontal spacing units with

a black box shaded in yellow, with the larger area identified in a red box.

5. **Matador Exhibit D-2** is a subsea structure map that I prepared for the top of the

Bone Spring formation. The contour interval is 50 feet. The structure map shows the Bone Spring

formation gently dipping to the east. The structure appears consistent across the proposed spacing

unit and I do not observe any faulting, pinch outs, or other geologic impediments to horizontal

drilling.

6. Also included on Matador Exhibit D-2 is a line of cross section from A to A'.

- 7. **Matador Exhibit D-3** is a structural cross-section that I prepared displaying openhole logs run over the Bone Spring formation from the three representative wells denoted from A to A'. For each well in the cross-section, the following logs are included: gamma ray, resistivity, and porosity. The proposed target intervals of each of the respective proposed wells is labeled and marked with a yellow shaded area. The logs in the cross-section demonstrate that the targeted intervals, within the Bone Spring formation, are consistent in thickness across the entirety of the proposed spacing unit.
- 8. Based on my geologic study of the area, I have not identified any geologic impediments to drilling horizontal wells within the Bone Spring formation in the area of the spacing units proposed in these cases.
- 9. In my opinion, each quarter-quarter section will be productive and contribute more-or-less equally to production from each respective horizontal spacing unit.
- 10. In my opinion, horizontal drilling will be the most efficient method to develop this acreage, to prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, and to result in the greatest ultimate recovery.
- 11. Approving Matador's applications will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste, and protection of correlative rights.


