The unit will be dedicated to the Cedar 3231 Fed. Com. Well No. 123H, with a first take point in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 32 and a last take point in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 31

<u>Case No. 21992</u>: Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2S/2 of Section 32 and S/2S/2

of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Cedar 3231 Fed. Com. Well No. 124H, with a first take point in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 32 and a last take point in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 31.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, completing, and equipping the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, and equipping the wells.
