#### APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Catena seeks to amend Order No. R-21492 ("Order") to allow for an extension of time for drilling the proposed initial well under the Order. Division Order No. R-21492, entered on October 13, 2020, in Case No. 21459, created a standard 640-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of the E/2 of Sections 6 and 7, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the "Unit"), and designated Catena as operator of the Unit. Order No. R-21492 further pooled the uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation (Scharb; Wolfcamp pool [55640]) in the Unit and dedicated the Unit to the proposed initial

Mariner 193507 1H well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit

A) of Section 18 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 6

Catena therefore requests that the deadline to commence drilling under the pooling order be extended for a year, to <u>October 13, 2022</u>.
