APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2S/2 of Section 36 and the S/2S/2 of Section 35, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the S/2S/2 of Section 36 and the S/2S/2 of Section 35, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill the Wild Turkey 36/35 B2PM State Com. Well No. 1H to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation, and to dedicate the S/2S/2 of Section 36 and the S/2S/2 of Section 35 to the well. The well has a first take point in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 36 and a last take point in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 35.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the S/2S/2 of Section 36 and the S/2S/2 of Section 35 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone

Spring formation underlying S/2S/2 of Section 36 and the S/2S/2 of Section 35, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying the S/2S/2 of Section 36 and the S/2S/2 of Section 35 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying the S/2S/2 of Section 36 and the S/2S/2 of Section 35;
- B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling, completing, and equipping the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, and equipping the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation in a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2S/2 of Section 36 and the S/2S/2 of Section 35, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Wild Turkey 36/35 B2PM State Com. VERIFIED STATEMENT OF ADRIANA SALGADO

Adriana Salgado, being duly sworn upon her oath, deposes and states:

- 1. I am a Landman for Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have worked as a landman for two years. I hold a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Humanities from the University of Texas of the Permian Basin. I have 4 years of land work experience with Apache Corporation, prior to working at Mewbourne Oil Company. Collectively, I have 11 years of land work experience.
- 2. Pursuant to NMAC 19.15.4.12.A(1), the following information is submitted in support of the compulsory pooling application filed herein:
 - (a) The purpose of this application is to force pool working interest owners into the Bone Spring formation [Palmillo: Bone Spring East Pool (49553)] horizontal spacing unit described below, and in wells to be drilled in the unit.
 - (b) No opposition is expected because the interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed wells but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests to the well. All interest owners have been located.
 - (c) A plat outlining the unit being pooled is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. Mewbourne seeks an order approving a 320.00-acre horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the S2S2 of Section 36 and the S2S2 of Section 35, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the Wild Turkey 36/35 B2PM State Com #1H.
 - (d) The parties being pooled and their interests are set forth in Exhibit 2. Their current and correct addresses are also set forth.

- (e) Exhibit 3 contains a summary of contacts with the interest owners, together with copies of the proposal letters sent to them, delivery receipts for each and copies of all email correspondence as listed.
- (f) In order to locate the interest owners, Mewbourne examined the county records, performed internet searches, checked telephone records, and searched pertinent computer searches.
- (g) Mewbourne has made a good faith effort to obtain the voluntary joinder of the working interest owners in the proposed well.
- (h) Mewbourne has the right to pool the overriding royalty owners in the well unit.
- (i) Exhibit 4 is the Authorization for Expenditure for the proposed well. The estimated cost of the well set forth therein is fair and reasonable, and is comparable to the costs of other wells of similar depth and length drilled in this area Lea County.
- (j) Mewbourne requests overhead and administrative rates of \$8000/month for a drilling well and \$800/month for a producing well. These rates are fair, and comparable to the rates charged by other operators for wells of this type in this portion of Lea County. Mewbourne requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the standard COPAS. Accounting Procedure.
- (k) Mewbourne requests that the maximum cost plus 200% risk charge be assessed against non-consenting working interest owners.
- (l) Applicant requests that it be designated operator of the well.
- (m) The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me or under my supervision, or compiled from company business records.
- (n) The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

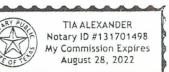

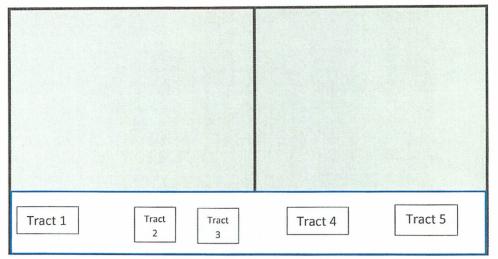
