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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Under Case 22859, COG seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation (Mesa Verde; Bone Spring [96229]) underlying a standard 480-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of Lots 1 and 2, S/2 NE/4 and SE/4 (equivalent to the E/2) of Section 5, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, and the SE/4 of Section 32, Township 23 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. COG

seeks to dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the following proposed wells:

- the **Gin and Tectonic Fed Com #501H well**, to be drilled from a surface hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 5, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 32, Township 23 South, Range 32 East;
- the **Gin and Tectonic Fed Com #502H well**, to be drilled from a surface hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 5, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 32, Township 23 South, Range 32 East; and
- the **Gin and Tectonic Fed Com #503H well**, to be drilled from a surface hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 5, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, to bottom hole location in the NW/4 SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 32, Township 23 South, Range 32 East.

The completed interval of the **Gin and Tectonic Fed Com #502H well** is expected to remain within 330 feet of the adjoining quarter-quarter section (or equivalent) tracts to allow inclusion of these proximity tracts within the proposed horizontal spacing unit under NMAC 19.15.16.15.B(1)(b). COG has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all working interest owners in the subject acreage.
