STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Case No. 22638: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2S/2 of Section 22, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Puma Blanca 22 B2IL Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a first take point in the NE/4SE/4 and a last take point in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 22.

Case No. 22639: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2S/2 of Section 21 and the S/2S/2 of Section 22, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Puma Blanca 21/22 B2PM Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a first take point in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 22 and a last take point in the SW/SW/4 of Section 21.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, completing, and equipping the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, and equipping the well.


