- I, being duly sworn on oath, state the following:
- 1. I am over the age of eighteen years and have the capacity to execute this Affidavit, which is based on my personal knowledge.
- 2. I am employed as a Landman with Cimarex Energy Co.("Cimarex"), and I am familiar with the subject application and the lands involved.
- 3. I graduated in 2010 from Texas Tech University with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration with an emphasis on Energy Commerce. I have worked at Cimarex for approximately 3 years, and I have been working in New Mexico for 3 years. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and made a matter of record.
- 4. This affidavit is submitted in connection with the filing by Cimarex of the above-referenced spacing and compulsory pooling applications pursuant to 19.15.4.12.A(1).
- 5. Cimarex seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest in the Bone Springformation (Carlsbad; Bone Spring, South; Pool Code: 9670) underlying a standard 320-

acre, more or less, horizontal spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Sections 29 and 32, Township 25 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

- 6. Under <u>Case No. 22771</u>, Cimarex seeks to dedicate the **Southern Hills 32-29 State Fed Com 1H Well**(API 30-015-49513) as an initial well, horizontally drilled from a surfacelocationinSE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 32 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 29; approximate TVD of 7,900'; approximate TMD of 17,900'; FTP in Section 32: 100' FSL, 330' FWL; LTP in Section 29: 100' FNL, 330' FWL.
- 7. Cimarex has a horizontal well, the Cottonwood Hills 32 State Com 2H (API No. 30-015-40184), in the W/2 W/2 of Section 32, in the Bone Spring formation. COG Operating, LLC has a horizontal well, the Populus Federal 2H (API No. 30-015-44103), in the W/2 W/2 of Section 29, in the Bone Spring formation. The proposed HSU will overlap these 160-acre units in the W/2 W/2 of Sections 32 and 29, respectively, and Cimarex respectfully requests approval, to the extent necessary, for the overlapping units.
 - 8. The proposed C-102 for each well is attached as **Exhibit A-1**.
- 9. A general location plat and a plat outlining the units being pooled is attached hereto as **Exhibit A-2**, which show the location of the proposed well within the unit. The location of each well is orthodox, and it meets the Division's offset requirements.
- 10. The parties being pooled, the nature of their interests, and their last known addresses are listed on **Exhibit A-2** attached hereto. **Exhibit A-2** includes information regarding working interest owners.
 - 11. There are no depth severances in the Bone Spring formation in this acreage.
- 12. I provided the law firm of James Bruce a list of names and addresses for the uncommitted ORRI owners shown on **Exhibit A-2**. In compiling these addresses, I conducted a diligent search

of the public records in Eddy County, New Mexico, where the wellsarelocated, and of phone directories and did computer searches to locate the contact information for parties entitled to notification. All working interest owners were locatable and noticed.

13. Cimarex has made a good faith effort to negotiate with the interest owners, but has been unable to obtain, voluntary agreement from all interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or in the commitmentoftheir interests to the well for its development within the proposed horizontal spacing unit. **Exhibit A-3** provides a chronology and history of contacts with the owners.

14. The interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed wells but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interest in the wells. However, Cimarex has been in ongoing discussions with some of the interest owners to voluntarily enter into a Joint Operating Agreement. If a mutually agreeable Joint Operating Agreement is reached between Cimarex and another interest owner or owners, Cimarex requests that the voluntary agreement become operative and supersede the Division's order for said parties, except to the extent the Division deems it necessary to maintain spacing criteria for the purpose of conservation, the prevention of waste, and protection of correlative rights.

15. The interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed wells, and the working interest owners have voluntarily committed their interests in the wells. This pooling application has been submitted for approval in order to account for the overriding royalty interest owners.

16. **Exhibit A-4** is a sample proposal letter and the AFEs for each proposed well. The estimated cost of the wells set forth in the AFEs is fair, reasonable, and comparable to the costs of other wells of similar depths and lengths drilled in this area of New Mexico.

- 17. Cimarex requests overhead and administrative rates of \$8,000/month for drilling each well and \$800/month for producing each well. These rates are fair and comparable to the rates charged by other operators for wells of this type in this area of southeastern New Mexico. Cimarex requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the COPAS Accounting Procedure.
- 18. Cimarex requests the maximum cost, plus 200% risk charge be assessed against non-consenting working interest owners to the extent needed.
 - 19. Cimarex requests that it be designated operator of the units and wells.
- 20. The Exhibits to this Affidavit were prepared by me or compiled from Cimarex's company business records under my direct supervision.
- 21. The granting of this Application is in the best interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights, and will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells.
 - 22. The foregoing is correct and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief.

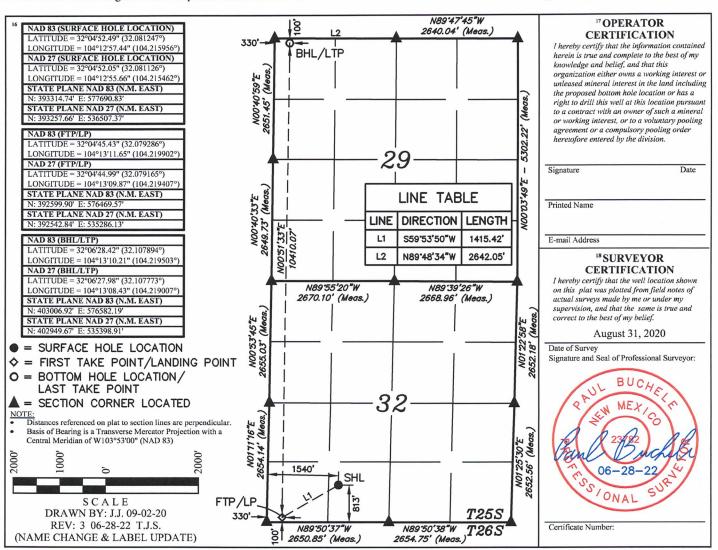

Abo has executed the proposed JOA and sent in their elections to participate in all proposed operations.

Oxy:

Well proposals for all four (4) wells sent on September 3, 2021. Update to 2H well plan via Update Letter sent on November 1, 2021. Initial contact with Oxy Landman, Courtney Carr, occurred on September 14, 2021. Oxy requested well plan information and received the information requested on October 20, 2021. Throughout the process of moving forward with a hearing to pool, we communicated regarding the terms and provisions of the proposed JOA. Requests for revisions sent over by Ms. Carr on October 21, 2021. Cimarex's comments to proposed revisions sent back to Ms. Carr on November 3, 2021. Ms. Carr advised on November 29, 2021 that she was waiting for feedback from her Legal Department on revisions in Article XVI. E., F. and H. This concluded the communication between Ms. Carr and myself.

Cimarex Energy Co. hereby proposes to drill the Southern Hills 32-29 State Fed Com 1H & Southern Hills 32-29-20 State Fed Com 2H wells at a legal location in Section 32, Township 25 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Southern Hills 32-29 State Fed Com 1H - The intended surface hole location for the well is 813'FSL & 1,540'FWL of Section 32, Township 25 South, Range 27 East, and the intended bottom hole location 100'FNL & 330'FWL of Section 29, Township 25 South, Range 27 East. The well is proposed to be drilled vertically to the Harkey formation and laterally in a northerly direction within the formation to the referenced bottom hole location. Total vertical depth of the well is proposed to be approximately 7,900'.

Southern Hills 32-29-20 State Fed Com 2H - The intended surface hole location for the well is 820'FSL & 1,558'FWL of Section 32, Township 25 South, Range 27 East, and the intended bottom hole location 100'FNL & 2,112'FWL of Section 20, Township 25 South, Range 27 East. The well is proposed to be drilled vertically to the Harkey formation and laterally in a northerly direction within the formation to the referenced bottom hole location. Total vertical depth of the well is proposed to be approximately 7,900'.

Cimarex Energy Co. is proposing these wells under the terms of a new Operating Agreement, which is included for your review and approval. It has the following general provisions:

- 100%/300% Non-Consenting Penalty;
- \$8000 Drilling and \$800 Producing Rate; and
- Cimarex Energy Co. named as Operator.

It should be understood that compliance with topography or cultural or environmental concerns, among others, might require modification of Cimarex's intended procedure. Cimarex will advise you of any such modifications.

- 1. I am over the age of 18, and I have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein.
- 2. I am employed as a petroleum geologist for Cimarex Energy Co. ("Cimarex"), and I am familiar with the subject applications and the geology involved.
- 3. This affidavit is submitted in connection with the filing by Cimarex of the above-referenced compulsory pooling applications pursuant to 19.15.4.12.A(1) NMAC.
- 4. I have testified previously by affidavit before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") as an expert petroleum geologist; my credentials have been made a matter of record, and I have been qualified as an expert by the Division.
- 5. Exhibit B-1 is a structure map of top Bone Spring Carbonate Formation with contour interval of 20 feet. The unit being pooled is outlined by a green rectangle. The structure map shows that there is a regional down-dip to the east. I do not observe any faulting, pinchouts, or other geologic impediments to developing this targeted interval
- 6. Exhibit B-2 is a stratigraphic cross-section flattened on the base of the Bone Spring Sand. Each well in the cross-section contains a gamma ray, resistivity, and porosity log. The cross-section demonstrates continuity of the target zone. The well logs on the cross-

section give a representative sample of the Bone Spring Sandstone target. The landing zone is highlighted by light, brown shading.

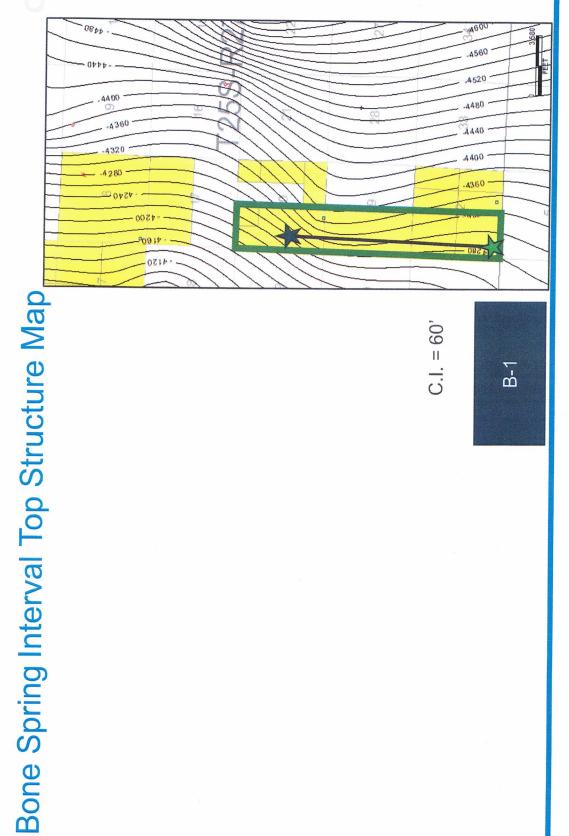
- 7. Additional exhibits for the benefit of the Division's review include **Exhibit B-3**, a gross isopach of the overall Bone Spring Carbonate interval, as well as **Exhibits B-4** and **B-5**. **Exhibit B-4** is a gun barrel representation of the unit, and **Exhibit B-5** is a structural cross section built along the wellbore trajectories. 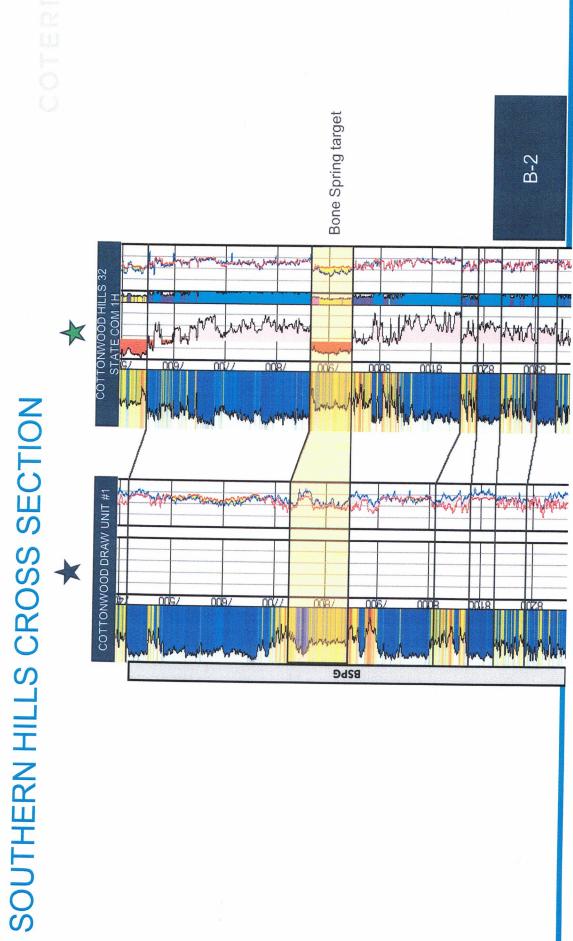

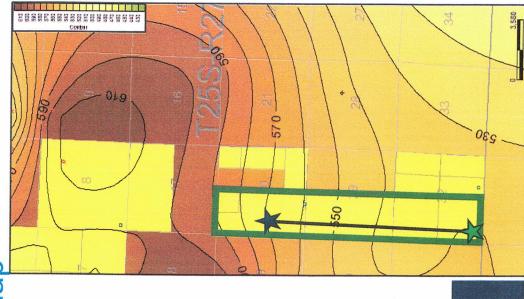
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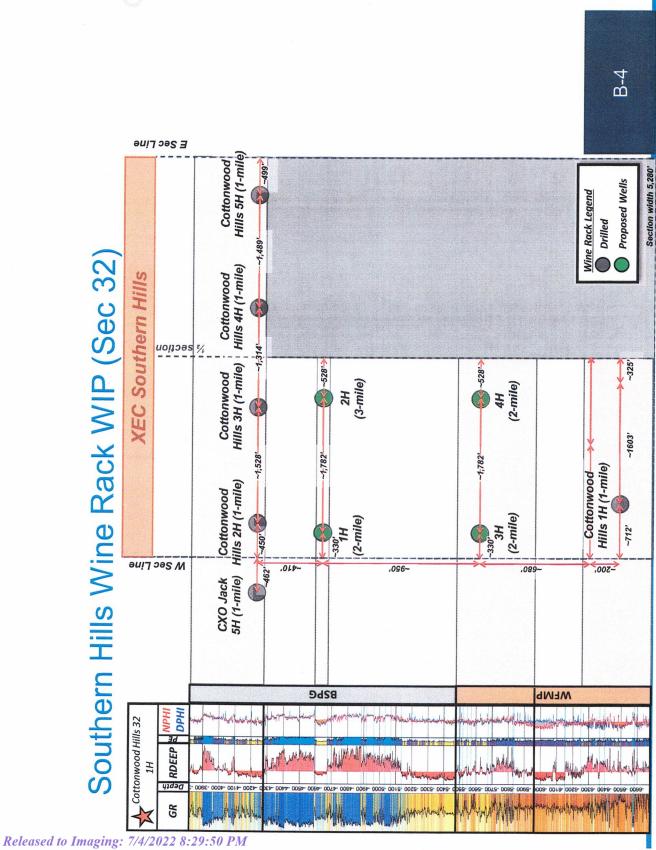
