- 3. AFFIDAVIT OF ROB HELBING

Rob Helbing, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, states the following:

1. My name is Rob Helbing and I am employed by MRC Energy Company, an affiliate

of Matador Production Company ("Matador"), as a Landman.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an

expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been

accepted by the Division and made a matter of public record.

3. I am familiar with the applications filed by Matador in these consolidated cases and

the status of the lands in the subject area.

4. In Case No. 22875, Matador seeks to re-open previous Case No 22052 and add

additional parties to be pooled under NMOCD Order No. 21811, which created a standard

horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the N/2 N/2 of Sections 14

and 15, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The spacing

unit was initially dedicated to the proposed initial Bubba Burton Com #111H and

Bubba Burton Com #121H wells, both with a first take point in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A)

of Section 14 and a last take point in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 15.

5. In Case No. 22876, Matador seeks to re-open previous Case No 22053 and add

additional parties to be pooled under NMOCD Order No. 21812, which created a standard

The spacing unit was initially dedicated to the proposed initial **Ken Wilson Com #112H and Ken Wilson Com #122H wells,** both with a first take point in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 14 and a last take point in the SW/4 NW/4 (Unit E) of Section 15.

- 6. **Matador Exhibit A-1** contains a draft Form C-102 for each of the proposed initial wells in these standard horizontal spacing units. These forms demonstrate that the completed interval for the wells will meet the standard setback requirements for horizontal oil wells.
- 7. Matador understands each of these wells has been placed in the Malaga; Bone Spring [42780] pool.
- 8. There are no depth severances within the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage.
- 9. **Matador Exhibit A-2** identifies the additional working interest owners that Matador is seeking to pool in these proposed horizontal spacing units.
- 10. Matador has conducted a diligent search of the public records in the county where the property is located, reviewed telephone directories and conducted computer searches in an attempt to locate contact information for each of these mineral owners. Despite these efforts, Matador has thus far not been able to locate many of these additional parties we seek to pool. For a number of these owners, the original proposals were returned as undeliverable. We then conducted additional online searches and attempted to mail the proposals to other addresses potentially associated with those owners that we had been unable to locate. These lands involve numerous small tracts that together between these two spacing units include hundreds of owners showing in our title. Matador was able to locate the majority of these owners and obtain leases or

other voluntary agreements. However, because we have not been able to locate and/or reach agreement with the owners listed in Exhibit A-2 we are proceeding to force pooling.

- 11. **Matador Exhibit A-3** contains a sample of the well proposal letter and AFE sent to the working interest owners Matador is seeking to pool. The costs reflected in the AFE are consistent with what other operators have incurred for drilling similar horizontal wells in the area in these formations.
- 12. **Matador Exhibit A-4** contains a general summary of the contacts with the uncommitted working interest owners that Matador was able to locate. In my opinion, Matador has undertaken good faith efforts to reach an agreement with the uncommitted mineral owners.
- 13. Matador requests that the overhead and administrative costs for drilling and producing the proposed wells be set at \$8,000 per month while drilling and \$800 per month while producing. These costs are consistent with what other operators are charging in this area for similar wells.
- 14. Matador has provided its outside counsel, Holland and Hart, with the names and addresses (where available) of the parties that Matador seeks to pool and instructed that they be notified of this hearing.
- 15. **Matador Exhibits A-1 through A-4** were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.

MRC Permian Company ("MRC") proposes the drilling of Matador Production Company's Bubba Burton Com 111H & Bubba Burton Com 121H Wells, located in the N/2 of Sections 14 & 15, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico to the Bone Spring formation.

In connection with the above, please note the following:

- The estimated cost of drilling, testing, completing, and equipping of each Well is itemized on the two (2) enclosed Authority for Expenditures ("AFE") dated May 20, 2021.
- **Bubba Burton Com #111H:** to be drilled from a legal location with a proposed surface hole location in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 14-24S-28E and a proposed bottom hole location in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 15-24S-28E. The Well will have a targeted interval within the Bone Spring formation and will be drilled horizontally in the Bone Spring (~7,300' TVD) to a Measured Depth of approximately 17,550'.

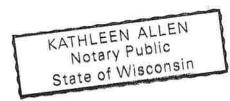
