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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

In this Case No. 23031, EOG seeks orders from the Division pooling the Bone Spring Formation (RED HILLS; BONE SPRING, EAST 97369) underlying the SW¹/₄ of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M. and the W¹/₂ of Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

EOG seeks to dedicate the above-referenced Bone Spring Formation horizontal spacing unit to the following proposed wells:

• The Honey Buzzard 35 South State Com #301H (API No. Pending), the Honey Buzzard 35 South State Com #302H (API No. Pending), the Honey Buzzard 35 South State Com #401H (API No. Pending), and the Honey Buzzard 35 South State Com #601H (API No. Pending), which will be horizontally drilled from a SHL in the NE½SW¼ (Unit M) of Section 35 to a BHL in the SW½SW¼ (Unit M) of Section 2; and

• The Honey Buzzard 35 South State Com #303H (API No. Pending), the Honey Buzzard 35 South State Com #402H (API No. Pending), and the Honey Buzzard 35 South State Com #602H (API No. Pending), which will be horizontally drilled from a SHL in the NE½SW¼ of Section 35 to a BHL in the SE½SW¼ of Section 2.

The completed interval for the proposed Honey Buzzard 35 South State Com #302H well (30-025-49750) will remain within 330 feet of the quarter-quarter line separating the $W\frac{1}{2}W\frac{1}{2}$ from the $E\frac{1}{2}W\frac{1}{2}$ of Sections 2 and 35 to allow inclusion of this acreage into a standard 480-acre horizontal well spacing unit.
