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**APPLICANT’S STATEMENT OF CASE**

In Case No. 23119, Devon seeks an order (1) establishing a standard 320-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Sections 22 and 27, Township 25 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral

interests in the Bone Spring formation, designated as an oil pool, underlying said unit. Devon proposes and dedicates to the unit the **Haflinger 22-27 Fed Com No. 304H Well**, as an initial well. The proposed well will be orthodox in location.

Devon proposes the **Haflinger 22-27 Fed Com No. 304H Well**, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 22 to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 27.

In addition, Devon informs the Division that although it had submitted its notice by publication in a timely manner to the newspaper circulated in Lea County, New Mexico, the notice by publication was not published in a timely manner due to circumstances beyond Devon’s control. As a result, Devon respectfully requests that Devon be permitted to present the Case at the scheduled hearing and an allowance be made for a continuance sufficient in duration to cure the defect in notice by publication.
