STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The Applicant in this matter has filed an application that seeks the following relief from the Division:

"An order pooling all mineral interests within the Quail Ridge, Bone Spring (Pool Code 50460), underlying Section 16, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico."

The Applicant seeks to dedicate this proposed spacing unit to the Cimarron 16 State Com #101H and the Cimarron 16 State Com #102H to begin initially drilling in the E2 of Section 16. The MRC Entities oppose this application and note Cimarex Energy Company has proposed the "Big Iron" wells in the Bone Spring formation underlying Sections 4, 9 and 16, Township 19 South, Range 34 East. *See* Attachment 1 (January 9, 2023, amended well proposal letter from Cimarex). This three-mile development plan competes with the one-mile wells proposed by the Applicant in this matter. The MRC Entities believe that the competing Cimarex development plan is more efficient and effective than that proposed by the Applicant in this matter.

APPLICANT'S PROPOSED EVIDENCE

At this point, the MRC Entities do not anticipate the need to present any evidence other than the attached well proposal letter from Cimarex Energy Company providing a competing

development plan for the E2 of Section 16. Matador may call as rebuttal witnesses the following individuals as needed:

By letter dated December 9, 2022 Cimarex Energy Co. hereby proposed to drill the Big Iron 4-16 Fed Com 103H, 104H, 203H and 204H and the Big Iron 4-9 Fed Com 303H and 304H wells. (the "Proposal to Drill") Please let this Update Letter serve as an update to BHL of the wells. Please note that this update is for advisory purposes only and all other information contained herein is identical to the original Proposal to Drill.

Big Iron 4-16 Fed Com 103H - The intended surface hole location for the well will be in the N2NE4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, and the intended bottom hole location is 100' FSL and 1978' FEL of Section 16, Township 19 South, Range 34 East. The well is proposed to be drilled vertically to the 1st Bone Spring interval and laterally within the formation to the referenced bottom hole location. Total vertical depth of the well is proposed to be approximately 9,370'.

Big Iron 4-16 Fed Com 104H - The intended surface hole location for the well will be in the N2NE4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, and the intended bottom hole location is 100' FSL and 708' FEL of Section 16, Township 19 South, Range 34 East. The well is proposed to be drilled vertically to the 1st Bone Spring interval and laterally within the formation to the referenced bottom hole location. Total vertical depth of the well is proposed to be approximately 9,370'.

Big Iron 4-16 Fed Com 203H - The intended surface hole location for the well will be in the N2NE4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, and the intended bottom hole location is 100' FSL and 1978' FEL of Section 16, Township 19 South, Range 34 East. The well is proposed to be drilled vertically to the 2nd Bone Spring interval and laterally within the formation to the referenced bottom hole location. Total vertical depth of the well is proposed to be approximately 9780'.

Big Iron 4-16 Fed Com 204H - The intended surface hole location for the well will be in the N2NE4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, and the intended bottom hole location is 100' FSL and 708' FEL of Section 16, Township 19 South, Range 34 East. The well is proposed to be drilled vertically to the 2nd Bone Spring interval and laterally within the formation to the referenced bottom hole location. Total vertical depth of the well is proposed to be approximately 9780'.

<u>Big Iron 4-9 Fed Com 303H</u> - The intended surface hole location for the well will be in the N2NE4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, and the intended bottom hole location is 100' FSL and 1978' FEL of Section 9, Township 19 South, Range 34 East. The well is proposed to be drilled vertically to the 3rd Bone Spring interval and laterally within the formation to the referenced bottom hole location. Total vertical depth of the well is proposed to be approximately 10,700'.

<u>Big Iron 4-9 Fed Com 304H</u> - The intended surface hole location for the well will be in the N2NE4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, and the intended bottom hole location is 100' FSL and 708' FEL of Section 9, Township 19 South, Range 34 East. The well is proposed to be drilled vertically to the 3rd Bone Spring interval and laterally within the formation to the referenced bottom hole location. Total vertical depth of the well is proposed to be approximately 10,700'.

It should be understood that compliance with topography or cultural or environmental concerns, among others, might require modification of Cimarex's intended procedure. Cimarex will advise you of any such modifications.
