This spacing unit will be dedicated to the **Treble State Com 701H** well and **Treble State Com 801H** wells, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for the wells is expected to be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Franklin Mountain Energy 3, LLC as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said wells. Said area is located approximately 18 miles west of Hobbs, New Mexico.
