### SELF AFFIRMED DECLARATION OF ILONA HOANG

Ilona Hoang hereby states and declares as follows:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a landman for Franklin Mountain Energy 3, LLC ("FME3"), and I have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my credentials as an expert petroleum landman were accepted by the Division as a matter of record.
  - 2. My area of responsibility at FME3 includes the area of Lea County in New Mexico.
- 3. I am familiar with the application filed by FME3 in this case, which is attached as **Exhibit B.1**.
  - 4. I am familiar with the status of the lands that are subject to the application.
- 5. I submit the following information pursuant to NMAC 19.15.4.12.A(1) in support of the above referenced compulsory pooling application.
- 6. The purpose of the application is to force pool all uncommitted interests into the horizontal spacing unit described below, and in the wells to be drilled in the unit.
- 7. No opposition is expected because the interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed well, but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests in the well.



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- 8. In this case, FME3 seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a 320-acre, more or less, Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit comprising the E/2W/2 of Sections 25 and 36, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
- 9. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the **Annex State Com 502H** well, to be horizontally drilled.
  - 10. Attached as **Exhibit B.2** is the proposed C-102 for the well.
- 11. The C-102 identifies the proposed surface hole locations and the bottom hole locations, and the first take point. The C-102 also identifies the pool and pool code.
  - 12. The wells will develop the Pearl; Bone Spring South pool (Pool code 49685).
  - 13. This pool is an oil pool with 40-acre building blocks.
  - 14. This pool is governed by the state-wide horizontal well rules.
  - 15. The producing areas for the wells is expected to be orthodox.
  - 16. There are no depth severances within the proposed spacing unit.
- 17. **Exhibit B.3** includes a lease tract map outlining the unit being pooled. Exhibit B.3 also includes the parties being pooled, the nature, and the percent of their interests.
- 18. I have conducted a diligent search of the public records in the county where the well is located, and conducted phone directory and computer searches to locate contact information for parties entitled to notification, and mailed the working interest owners well proposals, including an Authorization for Expenditure.
- 19. In my opinion, FME3 has made a good faith effort to obtain voluntary joinder of the working interest owners in the proposed well.
  - 20. **Exhibit B.4** is a summary of my contacts with the working interest owners.

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21. **Exhibit B.5** is a sample of the well proposal letter that was sent to all working

interest owners. The proposal letter identifies the proposed surface hole and bottom hole locations

and approximate TVD/MD for the well.

22. **Exhibit B.6** contains the Authorization for Expenditure for the proposed well. The

estimated cost of the well set forth therein is fair and reasonable, and is comparable to the costs of

other wells of similar depths and length drilled in this area of New Mexico.

23. FME3 requests overhead and administrative rates of \$9000.00/month for drilling a

well and \$900.00/month for a producing well. These rates are fair, and comparable to the rates

charged by other operators for wells of this type in this area of Southeastern, New Mexico. FME3

requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the COPAS Accounting Procedure.

24. FME3 requests the maximum cost plus 200% risk charge be assessed against non-

consenting working interest owners.

25. FME3 requests that it be designated operator of the well.

26. The parties FME3 is seeking to pool were notified of this hearing.

27. FME3 seeks to pool overriding royalty interest owners, and they were also provided

notice of this hearing.

28. **Exhibit B.7** is an affidavit of notice prepared by counsel for FME3 that shows the

parties who were notified of this hearing, the status of whether they received notice, and an

affidavit of publication from the Hobbs News-Sun newspaper, showing that notice of this hearing

was published on June 21, 2023.

29. The attachments to this declaration were prepared by me, or compiled from

company business records, or were prepared at my direction.

30. In my opinion, the granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

#### <u>APPLICATION</u>

Franklin Mountain Energy 3, LLC ("Franklin"), OGRID Number 331595, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a 320-acre, more or less, Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit comprising the E/2W/2 of Sections 25 and 36, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, Franklin states as follows:

- 1. Franklin has an interest in the subject lands and has a right to drill and operate a well thereon.
- 2. Franklin seeks to dedicate the E/2W/2 of Sections 25 and 36, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico to form a standard 320-acre, more or less, Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit.
- 3. Franklin plans to drill the **Annex State Com 502H** well to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation. The well will be horizontally drilled, and the producing area for the well is expected to be orthodox.
- 4. Franklin sought, but has been unable to obtain, a voluntary agreement from all interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying the proposed spacing unit to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well.

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5. The pooling of all interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the proposed

unit will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Franklin requests this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of

the Oil Conservation Division on July 6, 2023 and after notice and hearing as required by law, the

Division enter its order:

A. Pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a

horizontal spacing unit within the E/2W/2 of Sections 25 and 36, Township 19 South, Range 35

East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico;

B. Designating Franklin as operator of this unit and the wells to be drilled thereon;

C. Authorizing Franklin to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the

well;

D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together

with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in

the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.







Ben Kessel hereby states and declares as follows:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a geologist for Franklin Mountain Energy 3, LLC ("FME3"), and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my credentials as an expert petroleum geologist were accepted by the Division as a matter of record.
  - 2. My area of responsibility at FME3 includes the area of Lea County in New Mexico.
  - 3. I am familiar with the application filed by FME3 in this case.
- 4. **Exhibit C.1** is a locator map showing the approximate location of the proposed unit in relation to the Capitan Reef.
  - 5. **Exhibit C.2** is a wellbore schematic showing FME3's development plan.
- 6. Exhibit C.3 through Exhibit C.6 are the geology study I prepared for the Annex State Com 502H well, which will target the Second Bone Spring.
- 7. **Exhibit C.3** is a structure map of the Second Bone Spring formation. The proposed spacing unit is identified by a purple box. Annex State Com 502H well proposed in this case is identified by the black-dashed line. The contour interval used in this exhibit is 25 feet. This exhibit shows that the structure dips gently to the southwest.



- 8. **Exhibit C.4** is a cross-section reference map that identifies five wells in the vicinity of the proposed Annex State Com 502H well, shown by a line of cross-section running from A to A'.
- 9. **Exhibit C.5** is a stratigraphic cross-section, and the well logs shown on the cross-section give a representative sample of the Second Bone Spring formation in the area. The target zone is identified by a bracket and the words "Producing Interval." I have also identified where the proposed well falls within the wells I used for the cross-section.
- 10. In my opinion, the gross interval thickness for the Second Bone Spring formation increases to the south.
- 11. **Exhibit C.6** is an Isopach map of the Second Bone Spring formation. The gross interval thickness increases to the south.
  - 12. I conclude from the geology studies referenced above that:
    - a. The horizontal spacing unit is justified from a geologic standpoint.
    - b. There are no structural impediments or faulting that will interfere with horizontal development.
    - c. Each quarter-quarter section in the proposed unit will contribute more or less equally to production.
- 13. **Exhibit C.7** provides an overview of the stress orientation in the area based on the 2020 Snee-Zoback paper.
- 14. The preferred well orientation in this area is either north/south or south/north, nearly orthogonal to  $S_{Hmax}$ , optimal for inducted fracture propagation. This is because the  $S_{Hmax}$  is at approximately 255 degrees ENE in this area of Lea County.

- 15. In my opinion, the granting of FME3's application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.
- 16. The attachments to this declaration were prepared by me, or compiled from company business records, or were prepared at my direction.











### **Cross Section Reference Map**







### **Bone Spring Cross Section**




