STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Case No. 23765: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a proximity tract horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 28 and the E/2 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Lobo 33/28 Fed. Com. Well No. 626H with a first take point in the SW/4SE/4 of 33 and a last take point in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 28.

Case No. 23766: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2E/2 of Section 28 and the W/2E/2 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Lobo 33/28 Fed. Com. Well No. 715H with a first take point in the SW/4SE/4 of 33 and a last take point in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 28.

Case No. 23767: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 28 and the E/2E/2 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Lobo 33/28 Fed. Com. Well No. 718H with a first take point in the SE/4SE/4 of 33 and a last take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 28.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, completing, testing, and equipping the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, testing, and equipping the wells.


