APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2S/2 of Section 3 and the S/2S/2 of Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, containing 320 acres, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the S/2S/2 of Section 3 and the S/2S/2 of Section 4, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill the Judge 3/4 B3PM Fed. Com. Well No. 1H to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation (Parkway; Bone Spring Pool/Pool Code 49622), with a first take point in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 3 and a last take point in SW/4SW/4 of Section 4.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the S/2S/2 of Section 3 and the S/2S/2 of Section 4 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone

Spring formation underlying the S/2S/2 of Section 3 and the S/2S/2 of Section 4, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying the S/2S/2 of Section 3 and the S/2S/2 of Section 4 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying the S/2S/2 of Section 3 and the S/2S/2 of Section 4;
- B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling, completing, testing, and equipping the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, testing, and equipping the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF BRAXTON BLANDFORD

Braxton Blandford, being duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and states:

- 1. I am a landman for Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne"), and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have been qualified by the Division as an expert petroleum landman.
- 2. Pursuant to Division Rules, the following information is submitted in support of this application.
- 3. The purpose of this application is to force pool uncommitted interest owners into the standard Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit described below.
- 4. Mewbourne seeks an order pooling uncommitted working interest owners and Record Title owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2S/2 of Section 3 and the S/2S/2 of Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Judge 3/4 B3PM Fed. Com. Well No. 1H.
 - 5. There is no depth severance in the Bone Spring formation.
- 6. A plat outlining the unit being pooled is submitted as Attachment 2-A. A Form C-102 for the well is part of Attachment 2-A.
- 7. The tracts in the unit, the leases, and the parties being pooled and their interests, are set forth in Attachment 2-B. The persons being pooled are listed on Attachment 2-C.
- 8. The interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed well, but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests to the well. In order to locate the interest owners Mewbourne searched the federal and county records, performed internet searches, checked telephone records, and searched Accurint and Whitepages.


- 9. Attachment 2-D contains a sample copy of the proposal letters sent to the interest owners being pooled. It also contains a summary of communications with the parties. Mewbourne has made a good faith effort to locate and obtain the voluntary joinder of the working interest owners in the proposed wells.
- 10. Attachment 2-E contains the Authorization for Expenditure for the proposed well. The estimated cost of the well set forth therein is fair and reasonable, and comparable to the cost of other wells of similar depth and length drilled in this area of Eddy County.
- 11. Mewbourne requests overhead and administrative rates of \$8000/month for a drilling well and \$800/month for a producing well. These rates are fair, and comparable to the rates charged by other operators for wells of this type in this portion of Eddy County. They are also the rates set forth in the Joint Operating Agreement for the well unit. Mewbourne requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the COPAS Accounting Procedure.
- 12. Mewbourne requests that the maximum cost plus 200% risk charge be assessed against a non-consenting working interest owner.
 - 13. Mewbourne requests that it be designated operator of the well.
- 14. The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me or under my supervision, or compiled from company business records.
- 15. Granting this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.


WELL LOCATION AND ACREAGE DEDICATION PLAT

In Case No. 23689 Mewbourne seeks an order pooling the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2N/2 of Section 3 and the S/2N/2 of Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Judge 3/4 B3HE Fed. Com. Well No. 1H;

In Case No. 23690 Mewbourne seeks an order pooling the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2S/2 of Section 3 and the N/2S/2 of Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Judge 3/4 B3IL Fed. Com. Well No. 1H; and



- 4. The following geological plats are attached hereto:
- (a) Attachment 3-A is a structure map on the top of the Wolfcamp formation. It shows that structure dips gently to the east-southeast. It also shows a line of cross-section.
- (b) Attachment 3-B is a cross section showing the Third Bone Spring Sand, the target zone for the proposed wells. The well logs on the cross-section give a representative sample of the Third Bone Spring Sand in this area. The sand is continuous and uniformly thick across the well units.
- 5. I conclude from the maps that:
- (a) The horizontal spacing units are justified from a geologic standpoint.
- (b) The target zone is continuous and of relatively uniform thickness across each well unit.
- (c) Each quarter-quarter section in the well units will contribute more or less equally to production.
- (d) There is no faulting or other geologic impediment in the area which will affect the drilling of the subject wells.
- 6. Attachment 3-A shows that all Third Bone Spring Sand wells adjacent or close to the proposed well units are laydown wells. Based on our geological examination and information from offsetting wells, Mewbourne believes laydown well units are reasonable.
